RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING

WHEREAS, the Santa Barbara County Child Care Planning Council, the Pacific Coast Association for the Education of Young Children and other local organizations, in conjunction with the National Association for the Education of Young Children, are celebrating the Week of the Young Child, April 12th thru 18th, 2015 with the Annual Accreditation Open House Tour event on Friday April 24, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the WEEK OF THE YOUNG CHILD 2015 – “Celebrating Our Youngest Learners” – is a national effort to call attention to the need for high quality early childhood education programs and services for all children and families in our communities, to increase community involvement in early childhood issues, to foster continued involvement on the part of the community, to address child care needs and find local solutions, and to celebrate the joys of young children; and

WHEREAS, the future of our community depends on the quality of the early childhood experiences provided to young children today; and

WHEREAS, high-quality early childhood education programs and services represent a worthy investment and commitment to our children's future and should be recognized for their value to the community;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara, State of California, that said Board does hereby proclaim the week of April 12 - 18, 2015 as SANTA BARBARA COUNTY WEEK OF THE YOUNG CHILD and urges all citizens to recognize and support the needs of young children in our community, and to recognize and support the high quality programs that serve them.
