That the Board of Supervisors:

Authorize the Chair to execute Addendum No. 1, which provides a one year time extension and increases the professional service contract from \$267,500 to \$364,500 (an increase of \$97,000). This amendment would modify the existing professional design services agreement with Penfield and Smith Engineering (P&S) (a local vendor) for El Colegio Road Improvements-Phase II, County Project No. 864042.

Summary Text:

The El Colegio Road Improvements (Phase I and II) are a coordinated effort between UCSB and the County. The limits for the Phase I project are from UCSB Campus West Gate to just beyond the intersection with Los Carneros Road. The Phase I project will add two new traffic lanes on the north side of the roadway. The existing traffic lanes on the south side of the roadway through this area are not going to be improved as part of the Phase I portion of the project. Phase I is currently under construction by the University and is scheduled for completion in May, 2009.

The limits for Phase II of the project are from Los Carneros west to Camino Corto. Currently the scope of work for the improvements for Phase II only include the addition of two lanes on the north side of the roadway to match the Phase I improvements and no work to the south side of El Colegio.

El Colegio Road Improvements – Phase II, Addendum No. 1 for Professional Design Services Contract Hearing Date: February 17, 2009
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The purpose of amending Penfield and Smith's scope of work is to complete the detail design to ensure that the entire El Colegio roadway corridor is brought up to current roadway and American Disability Act (ADA) design standards, not only on the north side of the roadway, but the south side as well. The additional proposed improvements would remove a non-standard cross slope in the south side traffic lanes, replace non-standard ADA curb ramps with ones meeting current State and Federal guidelines throughout the entire length of El Colegio, and improve the drainage.

A request for a time extension is also included within the attached Addendum No. 1 for the purposes of completing this additional design work.




Figure 1: Original and Extended Project Limits

The limits covered by this amendment, as well as the original limits of improvements for Phase I and Phase II, are shown in Figure 1.

Background:

In compliance with County policy, the County advertised a Request for Proposal (RFP) for design services on the El Colegio Phase II Improvements. An evaluation committee from the County Public Works Department and the Redevelopment Agency evaluated the three proposals submitted based on a predetermined evaluation criterion. The committee ranked P&S Engineering as the most qualified firm and recommended that this firm be selected to perform design services for the project. On June 17, 2008 your Board approved and authorized the Chair to execute an agreement with P&S (File Reference No. 08-00487).

AGREEMENT OF SERVICES OF INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR EL COLEGIO IMPROVEMENTS – PHASE II PROJECT NO. 864042 – CONTRACT #BC09-077 <u>ADDENDUM NO.1</u>

This Amendment (hereafter amendment) is made by and between the County of Santa Barbara, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereafter COUNTY) and Penfield and Smith Engineering, having its principal place of business at 111 East Victoria Street, Santa Barbara, CA 93101 (hereafter CONTRACTOR).

The following items within the contract shall be modified as follows:

ITEM #3 "SCOPE OF SERVICES": Amend the scope of services to include the Board of Supervisors approved EXHIBIT A – "Original Scope of Work" (File Reference No. 08-00487) and EXHIBIT B – Additional Scope of Services for Addendum No. 1 attached hereto.

Therefore ITEM #3 shall be amended to read:

CONTRACTOR agrees to provide services to COUNTY in accordance with EXHIBIT A - "Original Scope of Work" and EXHIBIT B - "Additional Scope of Services for Addendum No. 1" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

ITEM #4 "TERM": Amend the expiration date of the contract from the original expiration date of December 30, 2008 to December 31, 2009.

ITEM #31 "MODIFICATION AMOUNTS": Amend the total amount of this contract from the original amount of two hundred sixty seven thousand five hundred (\$267,500) to three hundred sixty four thousand five hundred (\$364,500). Amend the increased compensation to CONTRACTOR of up to \$292,500 to \$389,500.

Therefore ITEM #31 shall be amended to read:

The total value of this contract is three hundred sixty four thousand five hundred (\$364,500). COUNTY Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of Public Works to make modifications as may be required by specific project requirements, to the service under this AGREEMENT and authorize in writing, changes in the service requiring increase compensation to CONTRACTOR of up to \$389,500. Changes requiring increase compensation which exceed \$25,000 must be authorized by the County Board of Supervisors. In no event may any changes in compensation be made without written approval by COUNTY in the form of an addendum.

All the other terms and conditions of the contract will remain in effect until the amended completion date unless notified in writing by CONTRACTOR or by the direction of the COUNTY. IN WITNESS WHERE OF, the parties have executed this amendment to be effective on the date executed by COUNTY.

EXHIBIT A

ORIGINAL SCOPE OF WORK

A. 35% Level Design Phase

- 1. Site visit to review field conditions and take photos.
- 2. Review available roadway layout plan provided by County.
- 3. Review available drainage concept study provided by County.
- 4. Attend a design kick-off meeting with County and design team to review project requirements, design approach and schedule.
- 5. Prepare civil design base plan in 1"=20' scale by merging the proposed road layout with the available El Colegio Road and Los Carneros Road topographic and utility maps, and showing existing and proposed right-of-way lines. Submit the design base plan to County for review.
- 6. Provide the design base plan to the design team.
- 7. Prepare 35% level design including pavement section, grading, drainage, typical sections and utility adjustments. We will design the pavement structural section based on the available geotechnical data provided by the County for Phase 1 design.
- 8. Prepare preliminary geometric control plan.
- 9. Prepare preliminary road profile along the center line and curb line.
- 10. Prepare preliminary road grading to join existing grades on El Colegio Road, Los Carneros Road and proposed grades from Phase 1 design at the El Colegio and Los Carneros intersection.
- 11. Perform supplemental topographic survey for obtaining precise grades along joining locations.
- 12. Prepare preliminary roadway drainage system design and connect to off-site drainage system provided by the County.
- 13. Prepare preliminary off-site drainage system design.
- 14. Prepare preliminary traffic striping and signage plan.
- 15. Coordinate utilities, i.e. water, sanitary, electrical, telecommunication, cable TV and gas line adjustments with utility districts and companies.
- 16. Prepare a preliminary earthwork quantity estimate.
- 17. Prepare cover sheet and plan notes.
- 18. Prepare Conditions of Approval sheet to list conditions provided by the County Planning approval process.
- 19. Prepare and organize preliminary construction cost estimate.
- 20. Prepare design report to summarize non-compliance items to County Standards.
- 21. Organize and submit 35% plans, cost estimate and design report to County for review.
- 22. Attend review meetings (total 2 times in this design phase).
- 23. Quality Control, constructability review and project management.

B. 65% Level Design Phase

- 1. Update design base plan based on the review comments from the 35% level design phase. Provide the base plan to the design team.
- 2. Prepare road design including grading, drainage, pavement section, erosion control, and utility adjustments.
- 3. Prepare preliminary road profile design along the center line and curb line.

- 4. Prepare geometric control plans.
- 5. Design and draft preliminary road cross sections.
- 6. Prepare preliminary traffic striping and signage plan.
- 7. Prepare preliminary construction staging and traffic control plan.
- 8. Coordinate utilities, i.e. water, sanitary, electrical, telecommunication, cable TV and gas line adjustments with utility districts and companies.
- 9. Prepare cover sheet, details and note plans.
- 10. Prepare Conditions of Approval Sheet to list conditions provided per the County Planning approval process.
- 11. Prepare a preliminary earthwork quantity calculation.
- 12. Prepare a preliminary drainage calculation for sizing roadway storm drain system. The proposed storm drain will connect to the off-site drainage system provided by the County.
- 13. Prepare a design report to summarize non-compliance items to County Standards.
- 14. Prepare and organize project technical specifications per County format.
- 15. Prepare and organize preliminary construction cost estimate.
- 16. Prepare responses to County's 35% QA/QC items.
- 17. Submit 65% level design plans, specifications, design report, response to QA/QC and cost estimate to County for review.
- 18. Attend review meetings (total 2 times at this design phase).
- 19. Quality control, constructability review and project management.

C. 90% and 100% Level Design Phases

In each of the 90% and 100% level design phases, we propose:

- 1. Prepare and update design base plans based on the review comments from the 65% (and 90%) level design phase and provide them to design team.
- 2. Prepare final design including pavement section, grading, drainage, and utility adjustments.
- 3. Prepare geometric control plans.
- 4. Prepare street profiles design along the center line and curb line.
- 5. Prepare cover sheet, note and detail plans.
- Prepare erosion control plans.
- 7. Prepare cross sections plans.
- 8. Prepare traffic striping and signage plan.
- 9. Prepare construction staging and traffic control plan.
- 10. Coordinate utilities, i.e. water, sanitary, electrical, telecommunication, cable TV and gas line adjustments with utility districts and companies.
- 11. Prepare drainage calculations to size roadway drainage system improvements, off site drainage system, and prepare a drainage report.
- 12. Prepare an earthwork quantity calculation.
- 13. Prepare a design report to summarize non-compliance items to County Standards.
- 14. Prepare and organize technical specifications in County format.
- 15. Prepare and organize construction cost estimates.

- 16. Prepare responses to 65% and 90% QA/QC items.
- 17. Submit and update design plans, specifications, drainage report, design report and cost estimate to County, GWD and GWSD for review at 90% and 100% design phases.
- 18. Address County and utility districts' design comments.
- 19. Attend review meetings (total 4 meetings).
- 20. Prepare Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) Report and Notice of Intent (NOI) to satisfy NPDES requirements.
- 21. Quality Control, constructability review and project management.

D. Bidding Services

- Attend pre-bid meeting.
- 2. Assist in bidding services, provide bidding information to the County and answer questions.
- 3. Prepare and organize addenda.
- 4. Update documents to incorporate addendum items.
- 5. Attend meetings (assumed 2 meetings).

E. Street Lighting Services

Provided by JMPE Electrical Engineering.

- 1. Street lighting plans design per County standards.
- 2. Photometric report on resultant light levels.
- 3. The street light will be located on the proposed center medium lane of El Colegio Road. It should light the proposed 4-lane road and the intersection.
- 4. Removal of existing lights.
- 5. Attend meetings.
- 6. Coordination with Penfield & Smith.

F. Landscape and Irrigation Services

Provided by Arcadia Studio.

a. 35% Level Design Phase

- 1. Visit the site to review and assess existing conditions and design opportunities.
- 2. Meet with the Penfield & Smith and supervising agencies as required to coordinate design criteria and preparation of documents.
- 3. Prepare schematic landscape design indicating locations of all trees, shrubs and groundcovers.
- 4. Prepare schematic irrigation design indicating mainline, point of connection and stations proposed.
- 5. Meet with Penfield & Smith and supervising agencies to review the design. (One meeting)
- 6. Revise conceptual landscape design based on comments from Penfield & Smith, UCSB and the County of Santa Barbara.
- 7. Prepare an opinion of cost based on 35% design.

b. 65% Level Design Phase

1. Refine conceptual landscape design and prepare preliminary landscape plan based on comments from Penfield & Smith and the County of Santa Barbara.

- 2. Coordinate with the Penfield & Smith as required regarding pavement and grading and drainage design.
- 3. Meet with Penfield & Smith and supervising agencies to review the design.
- 4. Coordinate design development with team consultants.
- 5. Prepare outline specifications.
- 6. Submit for preliminary design approval from supervising agencies prior to starting construction documentation.
- 7. Prepare an opinion of cost based on completed 65% level design documents.

c. 90% and 100% Level Design Phases

- 1. Prepare final planting plan and plant list locating and identifying quantities, sizes, and varieties of plant materials to be utilized in the design.
- 2. Design irrigation system and prepare irrigation plan depicting layout of piping, valves, control equipment, and sprinkler heads/emitters for the appropriate irrigation of the landscaping.
- 3. Prepare detail drawings and specifications as required to identify materials to be used, and to establish and specify standards for installation of the elements covered by this scope of work.
- 4. Meet with Penfield & Smith to review the drawings.
- 5. Refine construction documents based on comments from Penfield & Smith and the County of Santa Barbara.
- 6. Submit 90% level design construction documents to Penfield & Smith.
- 7. Prepare cost estimate based on completed landscape and irrigation construction documents.
- 8. Attend review meetings.
- 9. Revise construction documents based on comments from Penfield & Smith, UCSB and the County of Santa Barbara.

d. Bidding Phase

- 1. Prepare and submit bid documents to the Penfield & Smith for distribution to Bidders.
- 2. Answer questions and coordinate documentation of materials to the Client throughout the Bid Process.
- 3. Attend bid information meeting. (One meeting)

EXHIBIT B

ADDITIONAL SCOPE OF WORK FOR ADDENDUM NO. 1

A. Existing El Colegio Road Pavement and Curb & Gutter Improvements (Stadium Road to Los Carneros Road)

- 1. Review project requirements with the County to understand the project assignments.
- 2. Provide consultation and cost magnitude estimate to County for review.
- 3. Field visit to visually review curb and gutter conditions, mark damaged sections and compiled them onto the base plan.
- 4. Attend a design kick-off meeting with County to review design approach and schedule.
- 5. Prepare civil design base plan in plan and profile format. The base plan will show existing El Colegio Road with available grades, as well as the phase I construction as existing condition.
- 6. Prepare pavement cross section design per County standard. The design will include grades and typical sections and required utility final grade adjustments. The existing pavement will be removed and reconstruct with same pavement structural section as the Phase I project (on north side).
- 7. Prepare grading design at the El Colegio Road intersections with Del Norte, Del Mar, Pescadero and Los Carneros to transition from Phase 1 construction at each intersection.
- 8. Prepare the curb and gutter improvement design to show removal of damaged portion and reconstruct. Note that no sidewalk improvement design will be included in this proposal.
- 9. Prepare gutter profile along the existing southerly curb line and southerly median curb line.
- 10. Prepare traffic striping and signage plan, which will match existing conditions.
- 11. Prepare erosion control plan.
- 12. Prepare an earthwork quantity estimate.
- 13. Prepare cover sheet and plan notes.
- 14. Prepare details sheet.
- 15. Prepare construction cost opinion estimate.
- 16. Prepare book specifications including the front portion and technical sections.
- 17. Organize and submit 65%, 90%, 100% and final plans, cost estimate and replies to QA/QC comments to County for review. These designs will be included as a part of the Phase 2 design package.
- 18. Attend review meetings (total 3 times in design phase).
- 19. Quality Control, constructability review and project management.

B. Existing El Colegio Road Pavement and Curb & Gutter Improvements (West of Los Carneros Road to the West End of Phase 2)

- 1. Review project requirements with the County to comprehend the project assignments.
- 2. Provide consultation and cost magnitude estimate to County for review.
- 3. Field visit to visually review curb and gutter conditions, mark damaged sections and compiled them onto the base plan.
- 4. Prepare civil design base plan in plan and profile format. The base plan will show existing El Colegio Road with available grades, as well as the phase I construction as existing condition.
- 5. Prepare pavement cross section design per County standard. The design will include grades and typical sections and required utility final grade adjustments. The existing pavement will be removed to

- adequate depth and reconstruct with same pavement structural section as the phase I project (on north side).
- 6. Prepare grading design at the El Colegio Road and Del Sur intersection. Note that the Del Sur intersection will be a full intersection to provide access to UCSB Santa Ynez Apartments as directed by UCSB and agreed by the County.
- 7. Prepare the curb and gutter improvement design to show removal of damaged portion and reconstruct. Please note that no sidewalk improvement design will be included in this proposal.
- 8. Prepare gutter profile along the existing south curb line and south median curb line.
- 9. Prepare traffic striping and signage plan.
- 10. Prepare erosion control plan.
- 11. Prepare an earthwork quantity estimate.
- 12. Prepare cover sheet and plan notes.
- 13. Prepare details sheet.
- 14. Prepare construction cost opinion estimate.
- 15. Prepare book specifications including the front portion and technical sections.
- 16. Organize and submit 65%, 90%, 100% and final plans, cost estimate and replies to QA/QC comments to County for review. These designs will be included as a part of the Phase 2 design package.
- 17. Quality Control, constructability review and project management.

C. Prepare Gutter Flow Analysis

- 1. Prepare gutter flow analysis for the existing gutter and pavement conditions from Stadium Road to the west end of Phase 2 project. Note that we will not analyze the storm drain and drainage inlet capacity, and will assume drainage runoff will be completely received by underground system at each drainage inlet location for both pre- and post construction conditions.
- 2. Prepare gutter flow analysis per the proposed gutter and pavement conditions from Stadium Road to the west-end of Phase 2 project.
- 3. Prepare a calculation summary and submit it to the County for review and make 1 update. Note that this analysis will be submitted separately form the Phase 2 design package.

D. Prepare Ramp Improvements at Del Norte, Del Mar and Pescadero Intersections (6 Ramps)

- 1. Prepare field supplemental survey for existing 6 ramps on the south side of El Colegio Road intersections with Del Norte, Del Mar and Pescadero.
- 2. Compile the field survey data into AutoCAD and prepare design base plan.
- 3. Prepare ramp grading design by inserting County/Caltrans standard ramp (similar to the proposed ramp at Del Sur intersection in Phase 1 project). As a part of the ramp design, we will review the existing curb, sidewalk and parkway for their geometric and grades, and make required adjustments.
- 4. Insert the signal design on the Phase 1 project onto the proposed ramps, and adjust them to the proper location per the updated ramp design.
- 5. Submit the ramp improvements design in 4 submittals as a part of the Phase 2 project design package. The first ramp improvement design and signal location adjustment will be submitted earlier to accommodate the Phase 1 construction schedule.

E. Prepare Signal Design at El Colegio and Del Sur Intersection

1. Prepare signal design at El Colegio Road and Del Sur intersection. Note that the intersection will be modified to a 4-way intersection with new driveway entrance to Santa Ynez Apartments.

- 2. Coordinate traffic signal and street lighting design.
- 3. Submit the signal design in 4 submittals as a part of the Phase 2 project design package.

F. Prepare Construction Staging and Traffic Control Design

- 1. Prepare conceptual layout for construction staging and traffic control design including the existing pavement (south side) improvements between Stadium Road to Los Carneros Road, and the entire El Colegio Road improvements west of Los Carneros Road.
- 2. Meet with County staff to review conceptual staging and traffic control layout and receive comments.
- 3. Prepare construction staging and traffic control design per the County approved design concept.
- 4. Submit the construction staging and traffic control design in 4 submittals as a part of the Phase 2 project design package.

G. Bidding Services

- 1. Attend pre-bid meeting.
- 2. Assist in bidding services, provide bidding information to the County and answer questions.
- 3. Prepare and organize addenda.
- 4. Update documents to incorporate addendum items.
