SUBJECT: Construction of Gabion Faced (Retaining Wall) at 1440 Tunnel Road 1.2 miles north of Hwy 192 in Mission Canyon, Santa Barbara County Project No. 05STRM – 1T01 First Supervisorial District

Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Accept Notice of Completion for work performed by the Contractor, AIS Construction Company (not a Local Vendor), 4285 Crooked Palm Road, Ventura, CA 93001, and authorize Clerk to record.
- B. Review and approve the Statement of Final Quantities for work performed and materials supplied for this project by the Contractor, in the amount of \$148,129.21.

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendations are primarily aligned with Goal No. 1, An Efficient Government Able to Anticipate and Respond Effectively to the Needs of the Community.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

This project consists of repairing the failed slope and restoring the two way traffic near 1440 Tunnel Road. The repairs involved constructing a retaining wall with gabion face to repair adjacent canyon slope, reconstructing the road shoulder and pavement, and performing pavement traffic striping.

The Board of Supervisors declared an emergency and waived normal bidding and contracting procedures in January 2005 due to the winter storms. On April 4, 2005, the Public Works Director signed a letter awarding the construction contract to AIS Construction Company.

The Director of Public Works accepted this project as complete on July 5, 2005. The project was completed on time and on budget.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

The Federal and State governments both declared a disaster had resulted from the 2005 storms, thus making projects eligible for federal and state funding assistance. Under these circumstances, the County is usually responsible for 6.25% of project construction cost. In the fall of 2005, the State of California passed the “Pedro Nava Bill” which authorized the State to pick up the County’s 6.25% construction cost share. As a result, the construction cost for this project is being funded 75% by FEMA and 25% by the Governor’s Office of Emergency Services “Natural Disaster Assistance Act”. Funds were budgeted in Department 054, Fund 0015, Org Unit 0002, Program 2900, Account 7510 (OES) and Account 7511 (Measure D).
