WHEREAS, Guadalupe Swartz was a United States Postal Service Employee for 21 years, and a valued member of the community; and

WHEREAS, Guadalupe Swartz was at work on Monday night, January 30, 2006 when her life abruptly ended; and

WHEREAS, six other people's lives were also taken that night in a most terrible tragedy; and

WHEREAS, because of that tragedy, Guadalupe Swartz's family has suffered grief beyond description; and

WHEREAS, the entire community is also grief stricken and wishes to express its comfort, sympathy and compassion.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara commemorates the life and honors the memory of Guadalupe Swartz while expressing heartfelt condolences to her family in their time of profound sorrow.


Passed and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Santa Barbara County, State of California this 14th day of February, 2006 by a unanimous vote of all members present.







