WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors on September 19, 1960 adopted Resolution No. 20753, which established a 15-minute parking restriction on Broadway in the Orcutt area and on July 9, 1979 adopted Resolution No. 79-383, which established a 1-hour parking restriction on Broadway in the Orcutt area; and

WHEREAS, conditions have changed since these Resolutions were adopted and it is now in the best interest of the public to revise these parking restrictions;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED, Resolution No. 20753 which established a 15-minute parking restriction on Broadway in the Orcutt area and Resolution No. 79-383 which established a 1-hour parking restriction on Broadway in the Orcutt area at the following locations are rescinded:

- On the west side of North Broadway between its intersection with the north boundary of Clark Avenue and a point 50 feet northerly thereof, the 15-minute parking zone.
- On the west side of Broadway from a point 60 feet north of the centerline of Clark Avenue to a point 106 feet north of the centerline of Clark Avenue, the 1-hour parking zone.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Santa Barbara County Director of Public Works or designee is hereby authorized and directed to remove appropriate markings and/or signs at said locations as time and resources permit.
