RESOLUTION HONORING LISA MAGLIONE AS THE 2012 ANTI-DEFAMATION LEAGUE EDUCATOR AWARD RECIPIENT

WHEREAS, Lisa Maglione has been named as the recipient of the Anti-Defamation League 2012 Educator Award; and

WHEREAS, Lisa has been involved in educating the youth of Santa Barbara County since graduating from the University of California at Santa Barbara in 1979 with a Multiple Subjects Teaching Credential. Lisa returned to UCSB for her Administrative Services Credential in 1999 and a Masters of Arts in 2001 in Educational Leadership and Organization; and

WHEREAS, Lisa has served as a bilingual teacher and Assistant Principal at Peabody Charter School and Principal at Aliso School, where she received the Administrator of the Year for Celebrating Diversity by the Association of California School Administrators South Coast Charter; and

WHEREAS, in 2001 Lisa became Principal at Isla Vista School where she served until 2012. In 2006 her school was the first school in Santa Barbara County to exit Program Improvement Status under No Child Left Behind...proving "it can be done;" and

WHEREAS, after a decade of strategic and focused work Principal Lisa celebrated with staff and community bringing Isla Vista Elementary from the lowest performing school in the district to the top award in the state; and

WHEREAS, Lisa has accepted a new position as Santa Barbara County Director of Educational Support Services where she currently works.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors honors and commends Lisa Maglione for her outstanding contributions to our community and for being the recipient of the 2012 Anti-Defamation League Educator Award.
