RESOLUTION HONORING CYNTHIA WHITE AS THE 2010 ANTI-DEFAMATION LEAGUE EDUCATION HONOREE

WHEREAS, Cynthia White has been named the 2010 Education Honoree by the Anti-Defamation League; and

WHEREAS, Ms. White received a Bachelor's Degree in Spanish, a Master's Degree in Education, an Elementary Teaching Credential, an Administrative Services Credential, and a Ph.D. in Education, all from UC Santa Barbara; and

WHEREAS, Ms. White has been with the Santa Barbara School Districts since 1982 and has taught every grade level except first grade. She has also been a Coordinator of a Federal Grant for English Learners, an Assistant Principal, and a District Coordinator; and

WHEREAS, Ms. White's research and career have been dedicated to opening access to higher education for all students, and she has participated and supported the ADL training of A World of Difference and No Place for Hate programs; and

WHEREAS, Ms. White currently serves as Director of Curriculum and Categorical Programs, where she works behind the scenes to make sure that teachers, students and staff have the trainings, support and materials that they need to ensure equitable access for our most at risk students; and

WHEREAS, Ms. White has spearheaded programs such as AVID, a program that helps first generation students meet University of California entrance requirements, and READ 180, which helps struggling readers get back on track.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors honors and commends Cynthia White for her outstanding contributions to our community and for being the 2010 Anti-Defamation League Education Honoree.
