#### License Area 6

Existing Foundation Pad - 72" x 72" (102" diagonal) with 5 anchor bolts and electrical conduit. Artwork may extend beyond the limits of the existing foundation pad in the following dimensions:

- South 4-1/2 feet
- East 2 feet
- West 3 feet

Useable area is approximately 11 feet by 14-1/2 feet. NOTE: Access to bicycle hitching post must be maintained.

# STATE OF THE ART - SCULPTURE GALLERY PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION PERMIT - SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

- The following information must be submitted to the Public Works Engineering Counter at 630 Garden Street to obtain a Public Works Construction Permit. Within 14 days of receiving your submittal, the City will either issue a permit or provide written plan-check corrections. Submittals should be made as soon as possible to allow time to make any necessary plan revisions.
- The artwork must be confined to the approved License Areas.
- Artwork that conforms to the following <u>Size and Weight Requirements for Sculpture to be Exhibited on the State Street Plaza</u> is preferred:
  - 1. The sculpture shall be designed and attached to the foundation so that the weight and shape of the sculpture is approximately in the center of the foundation.
  - 2. The sculpture shall be fastened down with no less than three of the five anchor bolts in the foundation.
  - 3. The weight of the sculpture shall not exceed 3,000 pounds, and the piece shall be no more than 4 feet in width and 11 feet in height (as measured from the top of the foundation to the top of the sculpture).

<u>NOTE</u>: If the proposed installation does not conform to these parameters, the applicant must provide sufficient information for Public Works staff to make a determination as to the structural soundness of the installation. Plans prepared by a licensed structural engineer may be required in order to make such a determination. Public Works staff will not be available to provide design services.

#### SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Written Description Provide a description of the art element (including the size, weight, and construction materials) and a description of the proposed method of installation. Provide a signed statement from the Chairperson of the Curatorial Committee indicating that the selected artwork has been reviewed and approved in accordance with the selection process approved by the City Council.
- Site Plan Provide a <u>fully dimensioned</u> Site Plan identifying the proposed location of the artwork, the sidewalk width, any other encroachments in the public right of way, and dimensions of clearance between the artwork and all other features on the sidewalk, including the building frontage and the edge of street.
- 3. Elevation Plans Provide detailed and dimensioned Elevation Plans of the artwork itself, as well as of the proposed installation method. Provide specifications and dimensions for all connection hardware.
- 4. **Foundation Plan -** Provide a <u>fully dimensioned</u> Foundation Plan showing how the artwork will be installed either using the existing foundation provided by the City or by some other equally stable method. If a foundation other than (or in addition to) the existing is proposed, provide a plan showing details of construction, size and placement of reinforcing steel, anchor bolt size and location, and footing depth. Include cross-section drawings if necessary to adequately depict the proposed foundation.
- 5. Electrical Plan If any electrical work is proposed, provide an Electrical Plan, prepared by a licensed electrical engineer Include lighting details if applicable.
- 6. Traffic Management Plan Indicate how pedestrian and vehicle traffic will be re-routed during delivery, installation, and removal of the artwork. Call out any necessary street closures, sidewalk barricades, flagmen, detour signage, etc...
- 7. **De-installation Plan** Indicate the anticipated date of de-installation and method by which the sidewalk will be restored.
- 8. Plans must be legible, drawn to scale, and submitted on minimum 8 1/2" x 11" sheets.
- 9. Include the name, address, and telephone number of the artist, gallery representative, exhibit curator, engineer, and/or designer, as appropriate.
- 10. Fees Permit fees ranging from \$25 to \$240 will be assessed based on the complexity of the installation.
