WHEREAS, the Carpinteria Valley Historical Society is one of the oldest cultural institutions in Carpinteria Valley, having incorporated on June 10, 1959 with the purpose of collecting and preserving Carpinteria Valley's history and sharing that heritage with others; and

WHEREAS, as one of our County's oldest cultural institutions, the Carpinteria Valley Historical Society is a primary repository of our collective cultural heritage and ethnic diversity; and

WHEREAS, the Carpinteria Valley Historical Society collects, preserves, interprets, and exhibits the unique culture of the Carpinteria Valley, including Summerland, with a collection of over 40,000 irreplaceable historically significant objects and artifacts; and

WHEREAS, the Carpinteria Valley Historical Society educates children and adults through exhibitions, lectures, tours, and community outreach programs and through operating the Carpinteria Valley Museum of History exhibit galleries and the G. Horace Coshow Research Library; and

WHEREAS, the Carpinteria Valley Historical Society encourages research, scholarship, and publication of historical materials;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AN RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors honors the Carpinteria Valley Historical Society upon its 50 anniversary as the primary repository of the Carpinteria Valley region's collective cultural heritage and further commends the Society in furthering an understanding of and appreciation for our community's rich and diverse heritage.
