SUBJECT: Adoption of Resolution Authorizing the District Attorney to renew the Agreement

with the State for the Restitution and Recovery Program for FY 2005 and FY 2006.

Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors:

a) Adopt a Resolution authorizing the District Attorney to renew the Criminal Restitution Compact with the State Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board in the amount of \$91,500 annually for fiscal years 2005-06 and 2006-07.

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendation(s) are primarily aligned with actions required by law or by routine business necessity.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

This resolution authorizes continuation of a Criminal Restitution Compact, which was initiated in January 2000 to assist the State Board Revenue Recovery and Appeals Division to improve the criminal restitution system. The State has established contracts with various District Attorney Offices to maximize the recovery of criminal restitution fines, which is the source of financing for reimbursement of victim losses incurred as a result of a violent crime. This contract will provide \$91,500 annually for the next two fiscal years, which finances one paralegal position to ensure that statutory restitution fines and penalty assessments are included in court orders.

Mandates and Service Levels:

While not a mandated program, the Restitution and Recovery Compact will assist the State to maintain the integrity of the Victim Restitution Fund by maximizing recovery of restitution fines and penalties.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

The agreement finances the \$77,962 in salary & benefit costs \$4,023in operating costs \$9,515 in overhead charges for FY 05-06. Program expenditures and revenues are included in the budget. In FY 06-07 the \$91,500 will be budgeted for the same level of service.
