



RESOLUTION HONORING
THE 25TH ANNIVERSARY OF ADELANTE CHARTER SCHOOL

WHEREAS, in 2000, the Santa Barbara Unified School District (then the Santa Barbara Elementary School District) approved the charter for César Chávez Charter School, which opened in 2000 as Santa Barbara's first Spanish-English Dual Language Immersion school, establishing a legacy of bilingual, bicultural education that would later continue through Adelante Charter School; and

WHEREAS, Adelante Charter School (ACS) carries forward the pioneering vision of dual-language learning in Santa Barbara, serving as a K–6 Title I Spanish-English Dual Language Immersion program that empowers students to become biliterate, multicultural, and community-minded leaders; and

WHEREAS, Adelante Charter School, home of the Cheetahs, has been selected for the prestigious 2025 California Distinguished Schools Program, honoring schools across the state that demonstrate Exceptional Student Performance and success in Closing the Achievement Gap, reflecting its deep commitment to academic excellence and equity; and

WHEREAS, the mission of Adelante Charter School is to develop biliterate and multicultural students whose strong academic and cultural foundations prepare them to meaningfully participate and provide leadership in their families, community, and the world, guided by a vision of being a model dual-immersion program recognized for exceptional teaching, strong family partnerships, and community engagement; and

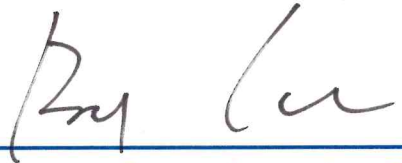

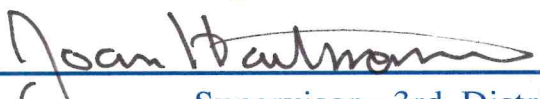

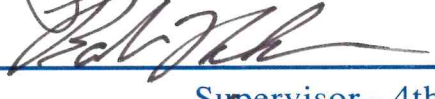
