- Community Wildfire Protection Plans (CWPP) originally in the Healthy Forest Restoration Act (2003)
- Engages, educates & empowers communities
- Agreed-to plan that:
 - Identifies
 - Prioritizes
 - Recommends

- Convened CWPP Working Group
- Leveraged published national resources
- Worked extensively with the Mission Canyon Association on process and content
- Identified a common process to improve effectiveness and community value
