That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Accept a \$110,000 cash donation from Santa Barbara Search & Rescue for use by the Sheriff's Department for purchase of equipment for the Special Enforcement Team, and
- 2) Approve Budget Revision #2006525 recognizing the donation and placing it into the designation for future law enforcement use.

Summary Text:

Santa Barbara Search & Rescue has presented to the Sheriff's Department a check for \$110,000. This donation will be used to purchase law enforcement equipment for the Special Enforcement Team (SET). The check was received December 22, 2006 and deposited with the Treasurer on December 28th, 2006.

The recommended action accepts the donation of funds and places them in a designated account. The Sheriff's Department will come to the Board at a future meeting with the appropriation requests to complete the purchase.
