

2025/26 (25STM3) Storm Emergency Response Report

February 10, 2026

Transportation Division Work as of January 27, 2026:

Transportation has been responding to the storm event 25STM3 under the Proclamation of Local Emergency declared by the Director of Emergency Services on January 9, 2026 and the Board Resolution 26-10 adopted by the Board on January 13, 2026. The following work to remove debris, clear culverts, implement protective measures, and perform emergency repairs on various County roads must be completed on an emergency basis in order to establish emergency and public roadway access, protect existing property, and alleviate financial impacts. Use of competitive procurement proposals or formal bids or awarding would delay the immediate action required to address public safety, access, and welfare.

Refugio Road Low Water Crossings and Bridge – Debris Clearing, 3rd Supervisorial District

General Project Work Description Debris clearing from road, culvert clearing, channel restoration, and pavement restoration.

Project Location Description: On Refugio Road, MP 0.3, Bridge 51C-218 and Low Water Crossings #1-6.

Contract Award: Raminha Construction, SCON-003352 - \$358,151

Camino Majorca at Del Playa Drive – Drainage Repairs – 2nd Supervisorial District

General Project Work Description: Replacing an existing culvert, replacing a concrete sidewalk, and stabilizing an eroded slope.

Project Location Description: On Camino Majorca at Del Playa Drive, extending approximately 200 feet south to the outlet.
