1. What are you requesting? Describe equipment or program support. Include brochures or photographs.

Ford F-150 XL with Snug Top camper shell and Weather Tech floor mats. This vehicle will be used to transport Santa Barbara County Fire Department Peer Support Team’s Emotional Support/PTSD Service Dog. The camper shell is required so there is a place to keep the dog and the handler’s fire department issued gear dry and where it will be separated from the handler. Fire gear is covered in carcinogens and will off gas while sitting in a car putting the handler in harm’s way. The reason for the dog screens on the camper shell is if the handler stops somewhere where he can’t or doesn’t want to bring the dog inside, the handler can open the windows in the camper and the dog will remain cool and safe. An F-150 is being is being requested due to the fact that the SBCo Fire Dept. purchases F-150’s and that their mechanics are familiar with the vehicle. In addition, parts are typically in stock. A full size truck is necessary in order to fit all Fire Department issued gear (structure fire gear, wildfire gear, “war” bag, USAR gear, etc.) and the canine. This vehicle will be driven all over the state to respond to incidents that may be emotionally challenging for first responders and the affected community. Some of the places may require 4x4 to access.

All Santa Barbara County First Responders, First Responders throughout the State, and the local and state wide communities.


5. Why are you requesting this equipment/program through the Alliance rather than your Agency?

7. Is ongoing maintenance for the equipment/program required? If so what are the anticipated costs for maintenance/replacement






