RESOLUTION HONORING JOE SCHER UPON HIS 90TH BIRTHDAY

WHEREAS, Joe Scher moved to Santa Barbara in 1981 after reorganizing his business and personal life. In Chicago, he was President of the Chicago Chapter of the American Jewish Committee and also a Director of the Birchwood Club. Along the way he married and had 4 children, now grown and 6 grandchildren, almost a full time job; and

WHEREAS, once in Santa Barbara, Mr. Scher devoted his energy to the acquisition of private properties as well as beginning to give considerable time to charity and enjoying the temple and Jewish Federation. His first job at Federation was chairman of the annual drive for funds. Under Joe's leadership, his first campaign drive raised \$150,000, a record; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Scher has served as Vice Present of the Federation for over a decade in addition to serving on every committee known to man; and

WHEREAS, his interest ran beyond the Jewish community and over the years also has served as: Chairman of Camarada Pacifica, President of the Foundation of SBCC for 4 years and as Director for 10 years, and Director of Speaking of Stories.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors honors Joe Scher for a lifetime of service to our community upon his 90th birthday.
