#### Purpose

#### Purpose of Safety Element Update (SEU):

- 1. Meet legislative requirements
- 2. Incorporate 2022 Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan
- 3. Meet legislative requirements addressed in CAL FIRE's Safety Element Assessment



## 1. Legislative Updates

- □ SB 1241(2012)
  - Address fire risk in State Responsibility Areas (SRA) and Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zones (VHFHSZ).
  - □ Findings for approving subdivision maps (addressed in 2015)
- □ SB 1035 (2018)
  - Update SE at least every 8 years with fire hazard, climate adaptation, and resiliency strategies.
- □ SB 99 (2019)
  - SE must identify residential developments with only one emergency evacuation route.



#### 2. Incorporate MJHMP

- On April 4, 2023, BOS adopted the 2022 Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan.
- BOS direction to incorporate the 2022 MJHMP into the Safety Element
  - County is eligible for a greater portion of State disaster funding.



## 3. Safety Element Assessment

- Safety Element Assessment
  - CAL FIRE standardized assessment tool
  - Determine if Safety Elements meet fire safety planning requirements (Gov. Code 65302)
  - Recommendations to mitigate or reduce wildfire risk



#### **Environmental Review**

- Exempt from CEQA
- § 15061(b)(3) No possibility of significant effect on the environment
- Notice of Exemption —Attachment B



# Fire Hazard Severity Zone Maps

- State Board of Forestry (BOF)
  - Currently updating FHSZ maps for the State Responsibility Area (SRA)
- □ Recommended Action "d"
  - Incorporate the FHSZ maps for the State Responsibility Areas into the Safety Element, once the maps are adopted by the BOF
