Set hearing for December 12, 2006 (Administrative agenda) at the request of Harwood A. White Jr., Agent for the Owner, to consider Case No. 06AGP-00000-00024, for non-renewal of an existing agricultural preserve contract.

- A. Accept the request for non-renewal of Agricultural Preserve 68-AP-10, and;
- B. Execute the attached Notice of Non-renewal of the County Land Conservation Contract for Assessor's Parcel No.'s 001-030-027 and 001-030-037, in the Carpenteria area, First Supervisorial District. (SET ON ADMINISTRATIVE AGENDA FOR DECEMBER 12, 2006)

Summary:

On November 3, 2006, the Agricultural Preserve Advisory Committee acknowledged the request of the landowner not to renew an Agricultural Preserve (68-AP-10), due to the need to fund probate taxes and plan larger home sites than allowed under the Uniform Rules of the County's Agriculture Preserve Program. The nonrenewal period of the contract will begin effective December 31, 2006. agriculture preserve contract on the subject property was entered into on December 9, 1968 and recorded on December 30, 1968. The site is approximately 43.5 acres and is used for an avocado orchard.

Background:

Section 51245 of the Government Code provides that if either the landowner or the County desires in any year not to renew an agricultural preserve contract, that party shall serve written notice of nonrenewal of the contract upon the other party in advance of the annual renewal date of the contract. The Agricultural Preserve Advisory Committee's position is that while it does not encourage removal of property from preserve status, it recognizes that pursuant to the Uniform Rules of the County's Agricultural Preserve Program, nonrenewal is an accepted method for terminating a contract when the landowner chooses to withdraw from the program.
