

Moon Jelly Life Cycle

**Egg Cluster**  
Eggs are released in a cluster. The eggs are fertilized and develop into a planula larva. The planula larva is a small, oval-shaped organism with a long tail. It swims in the water column and eventually settles on the bottom.

**Planula Larva**  
The planula larva is a small, oval-shaped organism with a long tail. It swims in the water column and eventually settles on the bottom. It feeds on organic matter and grows into a young jelly.

**Young Jelly**  
The young jelly is a small, bell-shaped organism with a short, thick, oral groove. It feeds on organic matter and grows into a mature jelly.

**Adult Jelly**  
The adult jelly is a large, bell-shaped organism with a long, thin, oral groove. It feeds on organic matter and reproduces by releasing eggs.

**Behind the Scenes**  
The moon jelly is a fascinating creature that has captured the imagination of many people. It is a simple organism, but it has a complex life cycle and a unique way of life.



## “MINI-EXPANSION” CREF PROPOSAL

- ▶ Aquarium program started with 1 student, in 2000 became a class, now operated by 4 classes with nearly 200 students.
- ▶ “Mini-Expansion” adds 20 tanks, 46 feet, and 750 gallons of saltwater exhibits.
- ▶ Adds almost 2,000 sq. ft. available exhibit space.
- ▶ Will welcome up to 12 school groups on each Tour Day, raising projected attendance from 5,000 to over 12,000 visitors annually.
