NAMI Santa Barbara County strongly supports the Public Defenders expansion requests for supervisory positions. For us, this is a simple calculation. The Public Defenders' Dept. is considerably underfunded as compared to other county departments. Despite limited staffing, according to its report the department repeatedly sets ambitious goals. It has met them, and even exceeded them. It has stretched in scope adding a number of new, valuable programs such as Holistic Defense and Early Representation requiring additional supervision requiring an expanded knowledge base. New programs need additional supervision as they are implemented, and supervisors are already stretched. We think anyone who reviews the department's budget presentation will agree that these additional allocations to the department will be well leveraged for its ongoing good work.

We also strongly support the Community Services Expansion Request for Emergency Shelters and Warming Centers. It is a modest sum. We know the need continues to grow, and we know the shelters and warming centers are chronically underfunded.
