RESOLUTION HONORING LEAGUE OF WOMAN VOTERS SANTA BARBARA EDUCATION FUND

WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters Santa Barbara Education fund was established in June 2000 to fund unbiased, non-partisan source of information that aids informed and active participation in government, essentially through the Voter Service and Citizen Education activities of the League; and

WHEREAS, the Education Fund is in support of the purpose of the League of Woman Voters to provide non-partisan information about issues on governmental processes and services enabling citizens to become active and informed voters, and to help every citizen participate in the democratic process; and

WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters provides non-partisan public candidate forums for County Supervisor, County Sheriff, City Council, and School Board. In addition, the League of Women Voters supports the production of "Touring with the Candidates" an informal interview of candidates that is aired widely on Santa Barbara Public Access in both English an Spanish; and

WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters produces an informative brochure and maintains a website including "Facts for Voters" providing information on registration, how and where to vote, customized ballot, and extensive information on candidates and ballot measures at the Federal, State and local level; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors recognize the accomplishments of the League of Woman Voters Santa Barbara Education Fund, and urges all members of the community to educate themselves on their rights and responsibilities relating to voter issues.
