What is the Action Plan?

- Annual grant application to U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development three federal entitlement grants:
 - Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)
 - HOME Investment Partnerships Act (HOME)
 - Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG)
- Includes funding reservations for projects during the operating year
- Describes how projects will meet federal objectives and priorities established in Consolidated Plan
- HCD serves as lead agency in the HOME Consortium and CDBG Urban County Partnership









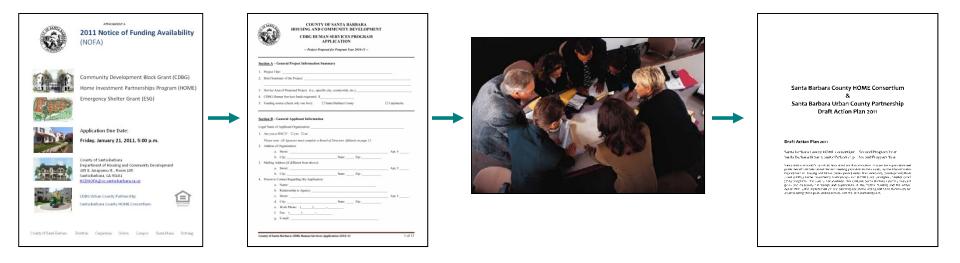








2011 Funding Process



- Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) published on November 15, 2010
 - NOFA emailed and mailed to over 200 interested organizations
 - Public Notice published in 7 publications of regional circulation
 - NOFA Informational portal published on HCD's website
 - Two public workshops held by HCD in Santa Maria and Santa Barbara
- Application period closed on January 21, 2011



HOME Summary

 Capital Loan Committee: Board approved committee including local lender, County Treasurer-Tax Collector representative, County Auditor-Controller representative, Public agency developer and local builder

• \$1,137,335 in HOME funding estimated available

- 10 applications for funding received
- \$4,162,894 in requests
- 4 projects recommended

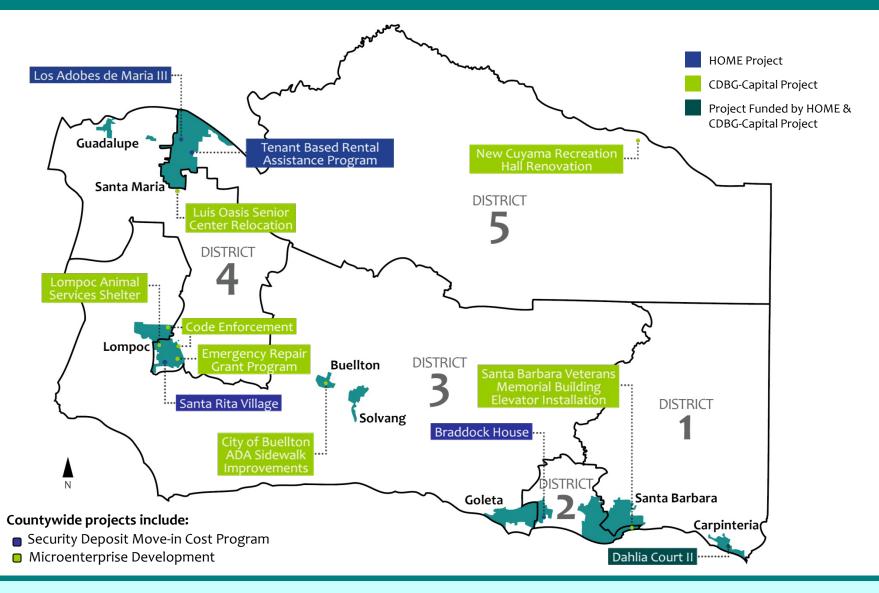
