WHEREAS, Alice caused one of the many reorganizations of the department after quietly marrying a certain staff member of the Division of Environmental Review; and,

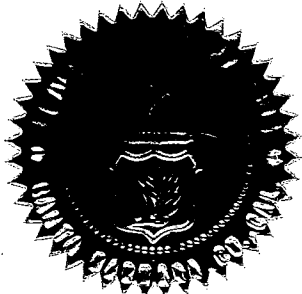

Her work lead to the first action by the District Attorney on a land use case and ultimately a \$1,000,000 judgment to Santa Barbara County.
