**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY AND DISCUSSION**

The intersection of Village Drive and Valley Drive is a 4-way uncontrolled intersection. A request was received to install stop signs at the intersection of Village Drive and Valley Drive. An investigation was performed at this intersection to determine whether stop signs were warranted. The results of this investigation showed that sight distance is restricted due to a slight curvature in the roadway and landscaping that is planted on the northeast corner of this intersection. Based on our investigation, it was determined that a 2-way stop on Village Drive at Valley Drive would be appropriate. The Public Works Department Traffic Section has prepared the attached resolution to establish a 2-way stop control at the following location:

- On Village Drive at its intersection with Valley Drive.
