RESOLUTION HONORING THE LYNDA FAIRLY CARPINTERIA ARTS CENTER IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Lynda Fairly Carpinteria Arts Center is a nonprofit organization established in 2001 to foster diverse community involvement, nurture the creative process and its appreciation, provide educational opportunities, and establish a center for the arts to enhance and enrich the quality of life in the Carpinteria Valley; and

WHEREAS, the Lynda Fairly Carpinteria Arts Center offers programs and events for all ages; free concerts; arts and music workshops for children, teens, and adults; Artist Studio Tour; Bellas Artes; Art in Film; Poetry; Photography Club; Artisans Marketplace; a gallery featuring local and regional artists, all of which serve people from the community and beyond; and

WHEREAS, the Lynda Fairly Carpinteria Arts Center collaborates with Girls Inc., Boys & Girls Club, Alcazar Theatre, Carpinteria Woman's Club, Carpinteria Unified School District, Carpinteria Library, Carpinteria Beautiful, Peoples' Self Help Housing, Carpinteria Community Garden Park, and Santa Barbara County Arts Commission for the benefit of all; and

WHEREAS, since 2002 the Lynda Fairly Carpinteria Arts Center programs have provided positive role models, cultural heritage, and arts education for thousands of children and families; and

WHEREAS, the Lynda Fairly Carpinteria Arts Center raised more than \$3.1 million to purchase and renovate a building for programs and professional galleries;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors honors the Lynda Fairly Carpinteria Arts Center, its volunteers and staff for dedicated service in the arts and further commends them for encouraging youth to explore their artistic creativity.
