

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE
COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

**IN THE MATTER OF ESTABLISHING
NO PARKING RESTRICTIONS
ON VARIOUS COUNTY ROADS IN THE
FIRST AND THIRD
SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICTS**

RESOLUTION NO. _____

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Sections 22507 and 22507.5 and the Code of Santa Barbara County, California, Section 23-11, authorize the Board of Supervisors of the County, to establish parking regulations on portions of roads and highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22651(n) authorizes a peace officer or a regularly employed and salaried employee who is engaged in directing traffic or enforcing parking laws and regulations of a county to remove a vehicle located in that county when it has been parked or left standing where local authorities, by resolution or ordinance, have prohibited parking and have authorized the removal of vehicles; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of public safety that certain portions of County highways in Santa Barbara County be designated as no parking, stopping, or standing tow away zones, in accordance with said Sections; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of public health and safety that certain portions of County highways in Santa Barbara County be designated as no parking tow away of oversized vehicles but only overnight between 10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M.; and

WHEREAS, an oversized vehicle has been defined in Santa Barbara County Code Section 23-11(l)(1) as any motor vehicle, boat, or trailer which exceeds at least one of the following criteria: twenty-four feet in length; seven feet in height; or eight feet in width; and

WHEREAS, the parking restrictions for oversized vehicles, pursuant to Santa Barbara County Code Section 23-11(l)(4), do not apply to certain agricultural vehicles when used in furtherance of bona fide agricultural activities; and

WHEREAS, these restrictions shall not apply to any service vehicle owned or operated by or for or operated under contract with a public agency or utility, whether privately,

municipally, or publicly owned, used in the construction, operation, removal, or repair of utility or public facilities, nor any transportation vehicles actively being used for public transit, nor any vehicle actively being used for the delivery of goods or services; and

WHEREAS, signs or markings giving adequate notice of oversized parking restrictions will be placed only at locations approved by the Board of Supervisors; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that the following locations in Santa Barbara County and under the jurisdiction of the Board of Supervisors of said County is hereby designated as no parking, stopping or standing tow away zones, or no parking of oversized vehicles tow away zones between the hours of 10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M., or no parking, stopping, or standing tow away zones between the times of Sunset to 8:00 A.M. or no parking, stopping, or standing tow away zones between the hours of 2:00 A.M. to 6:00 A.M., at the following locations:

No Parking, Stopping, or Standing Tow Away Zone

- On the south side of Via Real from the centerline of Greenwell Avenue to a point 280 feet west of the centerline of Toro Canyon Road.
- On the south side of Via Real from 360 feet west of the centerline of Sentar Road to the centerline of Nidever Road.
- On the south side of Via Real from 1340 feet west of the centerline of Nidever Road to 1120 feet west of centerline of Cravens Lane.
- On the south side of East Mountain Drive from the centerline of Ashley Road to a point 730 feet east of the centerline of Ashley Road

No Parking, Stopping, or Standing Tow Away Zone of Oversized Vehicles 10:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M.

- On the south side of Via Real from the centerline of Nidever Road to a point 1340 feet east of the centerline of Nidever Road.

No Parking Sunset to 8:00 A.M. Tow Away Zone

- On the north side of East Mountain Drive from the centerline of Riven Rock Road to a point 105 feet east of the centerline of Riven Rock Road.
- On the south side of East Mountain Drive from the centerline of Riven Rock Road to a point 295 feet east of the centerline of Riven Rock Road.
- On the south side of east Mountain Drive from the centerline of Hot Springs Road to a point 450 feet east of the centerline of Riven Rock Road.

No Parking 2:00 A.M. to 6:00 A.M. Tow Away Zone

- On both sides of Frontage Road #3399 (Arroyo Quemada) from the 101 State Highway to a point 3215 feet west of the 101 State Highway.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Santa Barbara County Director of Public Works, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to remove and/or change appropriate markings and/or signs at said location as time and resources permit.
