RESOLUTION HONORING QUENTIN LAVARR JOHNSON UPON ACHIEVING THE RANK OF EAGLE SCOUT

Whereas, Quentin LaVarr Johnson is a member of the Boy Scouts of America Troop 46 sponsored by the Solvang Ward of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day-Saints; and
