At the Planning Commission hearing of May 3, 2006, Commissioner Boysen moved, seconded by Commissioner Brown and carried by a vote of 5-0 to recommend that the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Report to the Board of Supervisors that, for the purposes of G.C. 65401, the complete list of new public works projects contained in the Five Year CIP (Attachment A of the staff report dated April 21, 2006) and recommended for planning, initiation or construction during the ensuing fiscal year conforms to the Comprehensive Plan.
- 2. Report to the Board of Supervisors that, for the purposes of G.C. 65402, the new public works projects listed in Attachment B of the staff report dated April 21, 2006 conforms to the Comprehensive Plan.
- 3. Request that the Comprehensive Planning Division forward the list of projects that may need future review under G.C. 65402 (Attachment C of the staff report dated April 21, 2006) because there is not yet sufficient project detail to make a determination to affected County Departments.
