# **Recommended Actions:**

Set a hearing for October 11, 2011 to receive a presentation on the *Laguna County Sanitation District Wastewater Reclamation Plant Facilities and Financial Master Plan*.

#### **Summary Text:**

In order to address the needs of the Laguna County Sanitation District treatment, storage and discharge facilities, a master plan was prepared. The plan, entitled the *Laguna County Sanitation District Wastewater Reclamation Plant Facilities and Financial Master Plan* was completed in July 2010 and addresses capacity, technology, regulatory, and cost issues associated with replacement and expansion of these facilities.

# **Background:**

The Laguna County Sanitation District wastewater reclamation plant was originally constructed in 1959 with a capacity of 1.6 million gallons per day (mgd) and consisted of conventional secondary treatment facilities. Additional upgrades have been implemented as follows:

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• 1974 to 2.4 mgd – Regulatory upgrade due to prohibition on creek discharge. Added grit removal, digester, storage and effluent pump facilities.

- 1986 to 3.2 mgd Capacity upgrade. Added secondary clarifier.
- 2001 to 3.7 mgd Regulatory upgrade to reduce salts per Order to meet Basin Plan objectives. Added tertiary filtration, reverse osmosis, disinfection, and brine disposal.

The Wastewater Reclamation Plant Facilities and Financial Master Plan studied the condition of the existing equipment, replacement needs, and the effect of planned development from the Orcutt Community Plan.

The plan will be presented to the Board of Directors on the Departmental agenda as indicated above and is expected to take 30 minutes.
