Authorize the Director of Public Works to advertise for construction bids for the Alamo Pintado Creek Bridge Repair (Br. No. 51C-081), County Project No. 05STRM (3T14).

Summary Text:

This project is located at County Bridge No. 51C-081 on Alamo Pintado Avenue over Alamo Pintado Creek approximately 0.3 miles south of Hwy 154 and 0.3 miles west of Grand Avenue in Los Olivos. The project consists of extending the existing pier wall support, installation of rock slope protection along the adjacent creek banks and at the bridge supports, realignment of the creek in the vicinity of the bridge, and construction of a weir structure to help control the scour of Alamo Pintado Creek in the area of the bridge.

The environmental impacts and mitigation measures for the Alamo Pintado Creek bridge repair project as they relate to the placement of grade stabilizers to protect public infrastructure were previously analyzed and approved under the Program EIR, (01-EIR-01) in Section 4.2. The Board of Supervisors approved the Addendum to the Program EIR for Alamo Pintado Creek bridge repairs in Section 3 of the Flood Control Routine Maintenance Plan for FY 2007/08 on June 19, 2007.

The "Notice to Contractors" will be published prior to the date set for the opening of the bids. Sealed proposals to construct this project will be received at the Public Works Conference Room, Santa Barbara County, Department of Public Works, County Engineering Building, 123 East Anapamu Street, Santa Barbara, California and at the North County Public Works office, 620 West Foster Road, Santa Maria, California, at a date to be determined, and will be opened publicly and read aloud.

Background:

During the initial series of storms of January 2005, unusually high creek flows caused scour and undermining of the existing grouted rock slope protection shielding the easterly abutment. The high creek flows also resulted in the undermining of the pier wall support resulting in exposure of the steel piles supporting the Alamo Pintado Creek Bridge.
