## Recommended Actions:

Approve and authorize the attached contract with the law firm of Kronick, Moskovitz, Tiederman & Girard to assist County Counsel in the representation of the Assessor in assessment appeals filed by the County's oil and gas companies.

## **Summary Text:**

The Board of Supervisors, under the provisions of Section 31000 of the California Government Code, is empowered to contract for special legal services and expert witnesses. Due to the specialized and complex nature of the issues presented in assessment appeals involving oil and gas companies, County Counsel seeks the assistance of attorney Brett Price of Kronick, Moskovitz, Tiederman & Girard. Mr. Price specializes in the representation of counties in cases involving the valuation of high value oil and gas interests. Mr. Price successfully represented the County in several appeals filed by Exxon in the late 1990's and early 2000's.

The assessed value at risk in oil and gas assessment appeal cases often exceeds \$100 million. The pending BreitBurn appeals are a good example. The assessed value at risk is \$402,421,557. At a tax rate of 1%, the amount of property tax at risk in the BreitBurn appeals alone is \$4,024,216.

Legal fees are estimated at \$100,000. County Counsel's line item designated for outside counsel is an appropriate source of funding for the proposed contract.
