**A Resolution of the Council of the City of Lompoc,
County of Santa Barbara, State of California,
Authorizing Renewal of a Cooperation Agreement Between the
County of Santa Barbara for Santa Barbara County
HOME Consortium for Federal Fiscal Years 2019-2021**

WHEREAS, the HOME Investment Partnerships Act under Title II of the Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act of 1990 (42 U.S. Code section 12703 *et seq.*) was enacted for the primary objective of increasing the supply of decent affordable housing to low- and very low-income residents; and

WHEREAS, 24 Code of Federal Regulations 92.101 provides direction under HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) for contiguous units of general local government to join together and form a consortium; and

WHEREAS, the County of Santa Barbara and the cities of Lompoc, Santa Maria, Goleta, Carpinteria, Buellton, Guadalupe and Solvang, not being individually eligible for formula allocation, desire to cooperate and participate in a consortium for purposes of receiving HOME funds and promoting affordable housing; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lompoc (City) first started participating in the Santa Barbara County HOME Consortium in 1997; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City to renew the consortium agreement so as to continue receiving an annual allocation of HOME funds to provide decent, affordable housing to low- and very low-income residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City approves joining the HOME Consortium with the County of Santa Barbara and participating cities for the HOME Program for the Federal Fiscal Years of 2019-20 and 2020-21.

SECTION 1. The Interim City Manager, City Manager or his/her designee is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to participate in the HOME Consortium Cooperation Agreement (Agreement) with the County of Santa Barbara and the participating cities for the HOME Program for Federal Fiscal Years 2019-2021 and to act on behalf of the City in all manners of business related to the functions of the Santa Barbara County HOME Consortium.


