Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendation(s) are primarily aligned with Goal No. 1, An Efficient Government Able to Respond Effectively to the Needs of the Community.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

On Tuesday, January 22, 2004, Eight (8) bids were opened for the Seismic Retrofit of Padaro Lane Overhead Bridge No. 51C-161 Federal Project No. STPLZ-5951 (094) near the town of Summerland in the First Supervisorial District of Santa Barbara County, County Project No. 862029. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Lash Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$434,306.60. Staff has performed an analysis of the bids received and has determined that the low bid is responsible and reasonable. Therefore, Staff recommends awarding this contract to Lash Construction, Inc.

The proposed project consists of seismic retrofitting Bridge 51C-161, by installing four 48" diameter cast in drill hole piles and two pile caps. The existing columns will be fitted with steel casings and their footings will receive an additional top mat of reinforced concrete. All the proposed work will be performed within the confines of the existing structure.

The installation of the new pilings and pile caps will require that Padaro Lane be closed from Highway 101 to the Loon Point Parking Area for approximately 6 weeks. Public Works has contacted the Padaro Lane Homeowner's Association and informed them of the closure. Prior to the start of construction, Public Works will mail out informational flyers to the residents along Padaro Lane. The detour will be to reroute local traffic to Santa Claus Lane for the duration of the closure of Padaro Lane.

No change in programs or service levels.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

The Federal Highway Bridge Rehabilitation and Replacement (HBRR) Program will fund 80% of the cost associated with the bridge replacements (\$374,817.54). Measure 'D' will provide for the 20% HBRR matching funds (\$93,704.39) which brings the total contract amount to \$468,521.93.

Measure 'D' funds have been budgeted in Dept. 054, Fund 0015, Program 2900, Account 7511.
