

12 To the Honorable the Superior Court of the
13 County of Santa Barbara, State of California:

14 Your petitioners, R. F. & W. G. Williams, herein
15 known as the Williams Corporation, respectfully represent:

16 1. That prior to the 6th day of August, 1890, R. F. Williams,
17 now deceased subdivided a portion of the original Rancho
18 in the County of Santa Barbara, State of California, situated about one
19 miles east of the City of Santa Barbara, and caused said portion
20 of said rancho to be surveyed, platted and mapped, and a
21 site laid out thereon known as the City, or Town, of
22 Summerland, and subdivided the same into lots and blocks, and laid
23 out a portion thereof as public parks, streets, avenues, and
24 places, and set apart other portions for other public purposes
25 designated upon a map or survey made by A. H. Cooper,
26 County Surveyor of said County of Santa Barbara, and filed in
27 the City of Summerland, Santa Barbara Co., 1890, by A. H.
28 Cooper, County Surveyor and recorded in book 18 of surveys
29 page 615 in the office of the County Recorder of said County
30 of Santa Barbara.

1 2. That on said 8th day of August, 1890, the said L.
2 Williams, deceased, in order to carry out his expressed
3 intention to dedicate said portion of said rancho to public
4 use as a townsite granted, conveyed, and confirmed to F. W.
5 T. Balch, Joseph Barnett, and W. H. Meginness all those
6 portions of said real property marked and designated upon
7 said map as, creeks, streets, squares, avenues, places, lanes
8 and alleys for the use and benefit of the public and the citizens
9 residents, and inhabitants of said City of Summerland to be
10 governed and controlled thereafter by the duly constituted public
11 authorities, saving and excepting all mines and minerals, gas
12 oil, asphaltum, clays, gypsum and other mineral substances
13 existing therein which were expressly reserved to said grantor,
14 his heirs and assigns.

15 3. That said Trustees, Edward P. Balch, Joseph Barnett,
16 and W. H. Meginness are deceased; that no successors in the
17 administration of said trust have been appointed; that said
18 declaration of trust does not provide any method of appointment of
19 such successors, and that by reason of said vacant trusteeship and
20 said failure in said declaration of trust to provide a practical
21 method of appointment the duty of appointing trustees to fill
22 said vacancy devolves upon the Court, as provided by Section 11607
23 of the Civil Code of the State of California.

24 4. That on the 16th day of June, 1916, the Board of Supervi-
25 sors of the County of Santa Barbara, on petition of the
26 Summerland Chamber of Commerce accepted, established, and declared
27 the streets and alleys of said Town of Summerland to be public
28 highways in Road District No. 1, First Township, County of
29 Santa Barbara, California.

1 Santa Barbara, State of California, and assumed by management
2 and control of the same.

5 5. That your petitioners do not question the legal
6 or the expediency, of the said option by said Board of Super-
7 visors of such management, and control, but they respectfully
8 represent that said Town of Summerland was at all times mentioned
9 herein, and now is, an unincorporated town, and that no legal
10 constituted body has, or claims, authority to administer the
11 said trust as to the parks and public places, or to hold the
12 same for the use and benefit of the citizens, residents, and
13 inhabitants of said Town of Summerland.

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16 6. That the appointment of trustees to fill the
17 vacancy aforesaid is necessary to prevent said
18 trust from failing and defeating the benevolent purpose of
19 the trustee.

20
21 7. That your petitioners are residents and property
22 holders of said Town of Summerland and interested in its
23 growth and prosperity, and that they are able, willing, and
24 ready to administer said trust according to said declaration
25 of trust and the orders of this Court.

26
27 8. WHEREFORE your petitioners pray that the Court
28 exercise the power conferred by Section 1887 of the Civil Code
29 of the State of California and appoint three trustees to ad-
30 minister said trust, your petitioners respectfully proffering their
31 services in such capacity in behalf of said Town of Summerland.



wherein he conveyed to them and the survivor or survivors of them
in trust /for the uses and purposes therein set forth, the fee simple
estate of, in and to, the streets, lanes, alleys, parks and
places, in the Town of Summerland, in said deed fully described,
to have and to hold the same for the benefit of the said Town
of Summerland, to be administered by said trustees, as in said
Deed of Trust provided, and to be held by them until said Town
of Summerland should be incorporated under the laws of this

That on, or about the 19th day of June, 1917,
