WHIREAS, Tom Parker is a third generation Santa Barbara native. He attended lefferson and Franklin Elementary Simools, Santa Barbara Junior High and graduated from Santa Barbara High School. He received both his undergraduate education and MBA at California Lutheran University, and;

WHEREAS, Tom is currently Chairman of the Betty L. Hutton Title Holding Company, Inc. and President of the Hutton boundation. The Hutton Foundation's primary areas of in crest include Health & Human Services, Arts & Culture, Edication, Civic & Community Development, Woman's Services, and Youth & Family Services. Funding is currently limited to Santa Barbara, Riverside and Orange counties in California. Since 1997 the Hutton Foundation has awarded from than \$16 million in grants, Program Related Investments and donations to non-profit organizations throughout Santa Barbara County. In addition the Hutton Foundation owns eleven commercial office buildings housing more than fifty non-profit tenants, has funded more than twenty-five individual low interest loans, helped establish more than a dozen new endowments and partnered with local media to produce more than sixty-five newspaper insants and fifty-six marketing videos, and;

WHEREAS, Tom also serves on numerous non-profit board and committees including. The Foundation Roundtable, the Santa Barbara Foundation Board of Trustees, The Foundation for Santa Barbara City College and the Goleta Valley Cottage Hospital Foundation Board. Tom is Past President of the Santa Barbara Museum of Natural History Board and served as Co-Chair of the Visiting Nurse & Hospite Care Serenity House Capital Campaign, and;

WHEREAS, Tom has received several community service awards including: The Santa Barbara News-Press Lifetime Achi[®]vement Award, Goleta Man of the Year, the Women's Economic Ventures Man of Equality Award, the Santa Barbara Independent's Local Hero Award and the Santa Barbara Chamber of Commerce's Albert Julius Boeseke Founders Award.
