# Street Lighting and Open Space CSA 3

### Revenues

- Street Lighting is funded by a combination of property taxes and benefit assessments
- Open Space is funded from property taxes

### Expenditure

- Street Lighting operations and maintenance as well as energy costs
- Open Space Maintenance is provided by the Parks Department


## Street Lighting and Open Space

- No Proposed Change in Benefit Assessment Rates
  - \$8 per year per Resident
- No Change in Service Level
- Deficit Spending of approximately \$10,000 in FY-09/10:

	CSA 3	Street Lighting
Revenue	\$849,135	\$190,500
Expenses	\$860,019	\$190,500

 Fund Balance estimated currently at \$255,000 and is expected to decrease over time.
