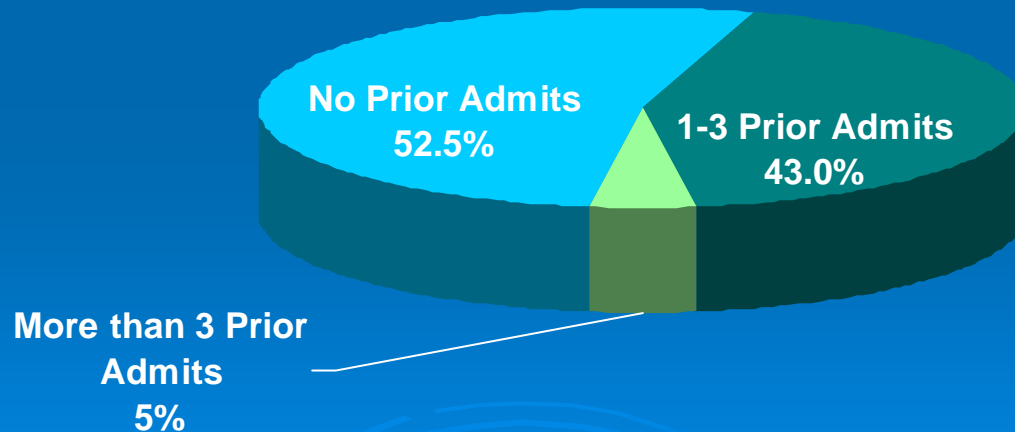
Substance Abuse Crime Prevention Act of 2000

- Provide drug treatment in the community rather than incarceration for non-violent adult offenders who use or possess illegal drugs to:
 - Preserve jail and prison cells for serious and violent offender
 - Enhance public safety by reducing drug-related crime
 - Improve public health by reducing drug abuse
- Local Program developed with criminal justice, treatment and other community partners
- Annual Services Plan requires yearly approval by the Board of Supervisors

Santa Barbara County Prop 36 Summary

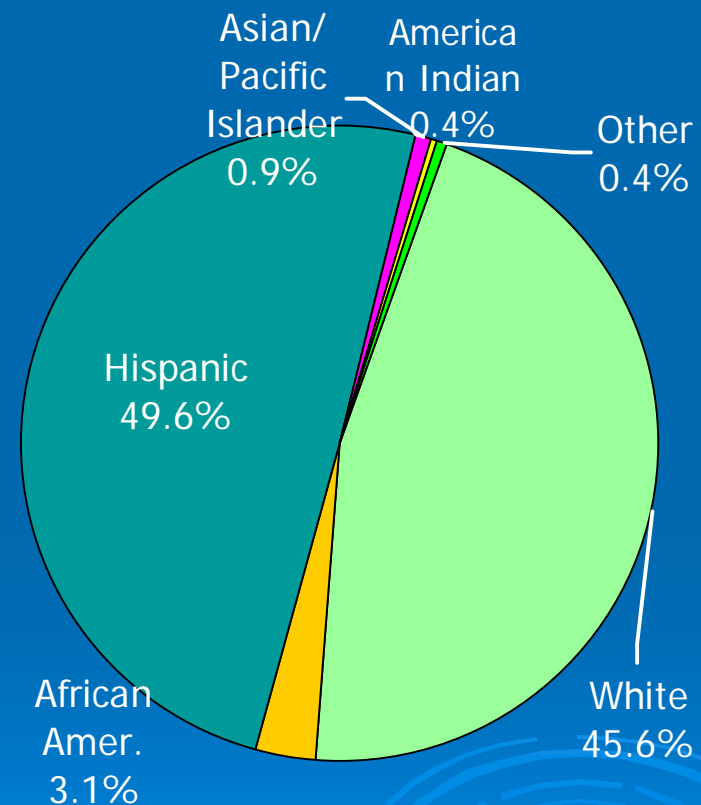
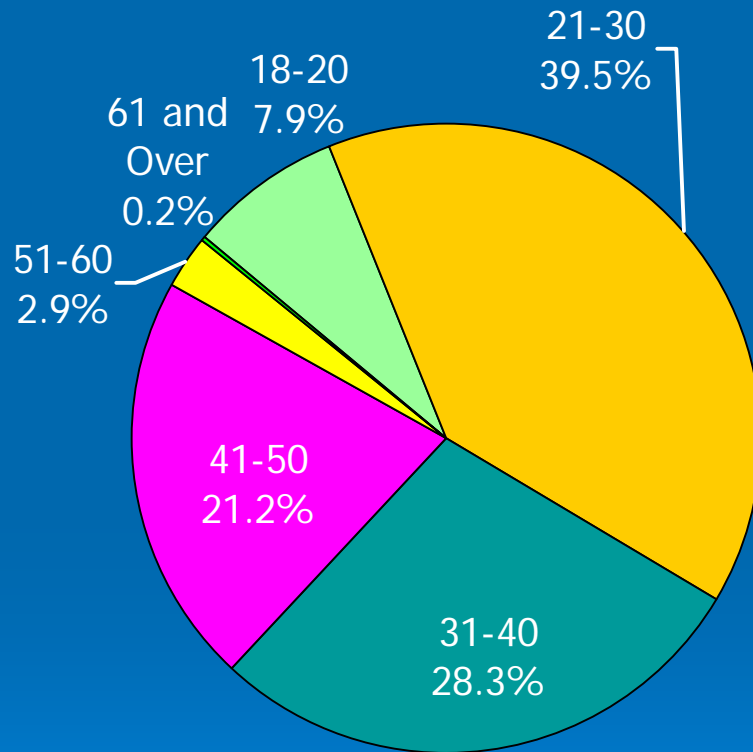
- Since inception, ADP providers have served 3,046 unduplicated SACPA clients ¹
- Average years of addiction: 11.7 years ²

Client Prior Treatment Admissions ³



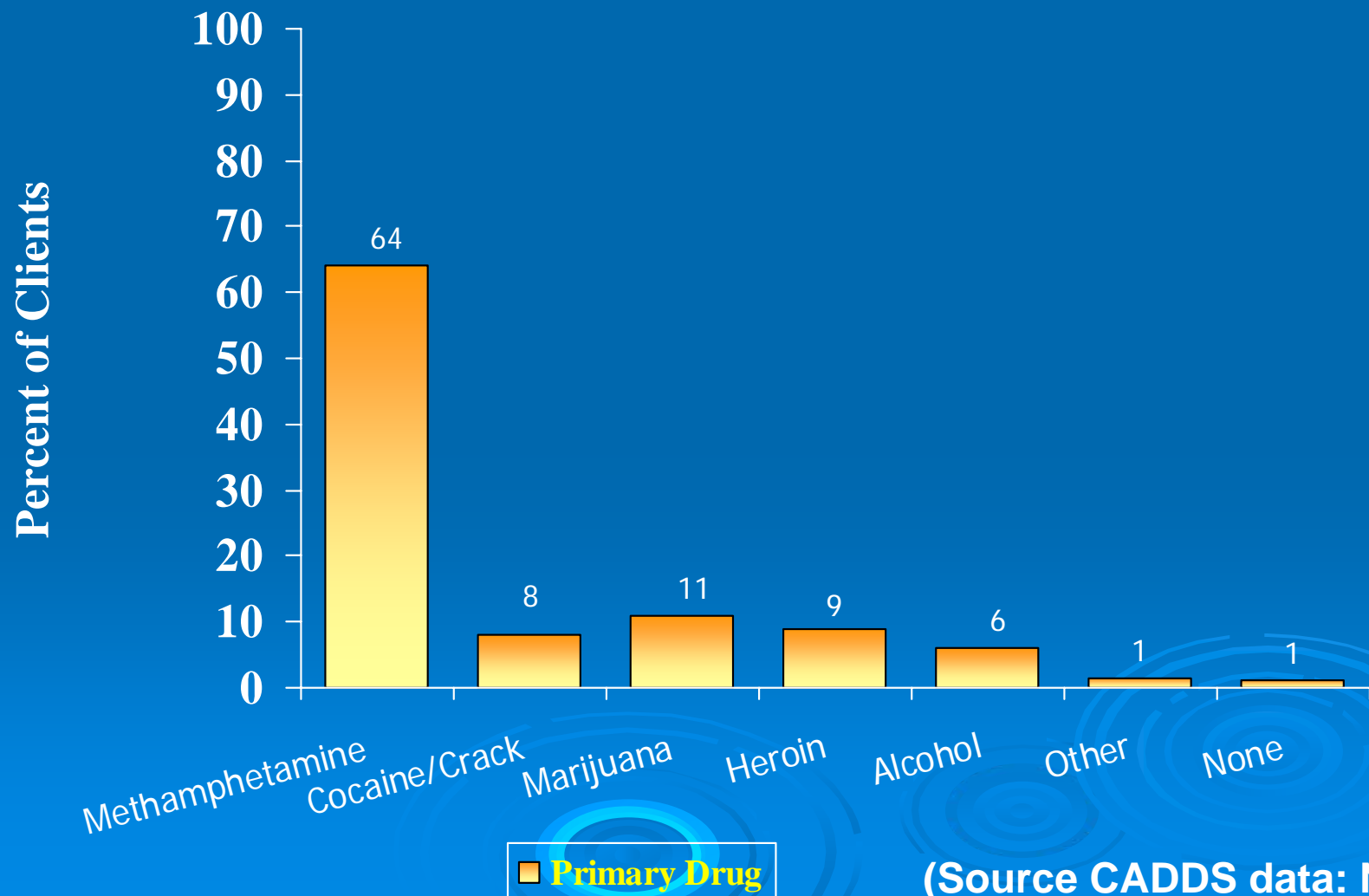

Age and Race/Ethnicity of All SACPA Clients FY 04-05



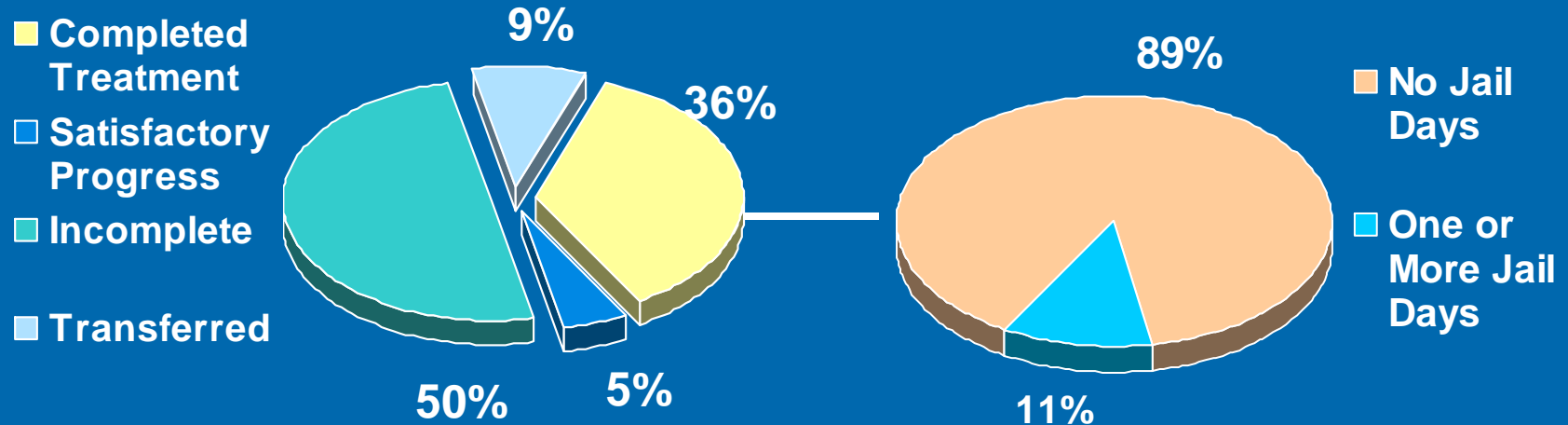

Primary Drug Among SACPA Treatment Admissions FY 04-05



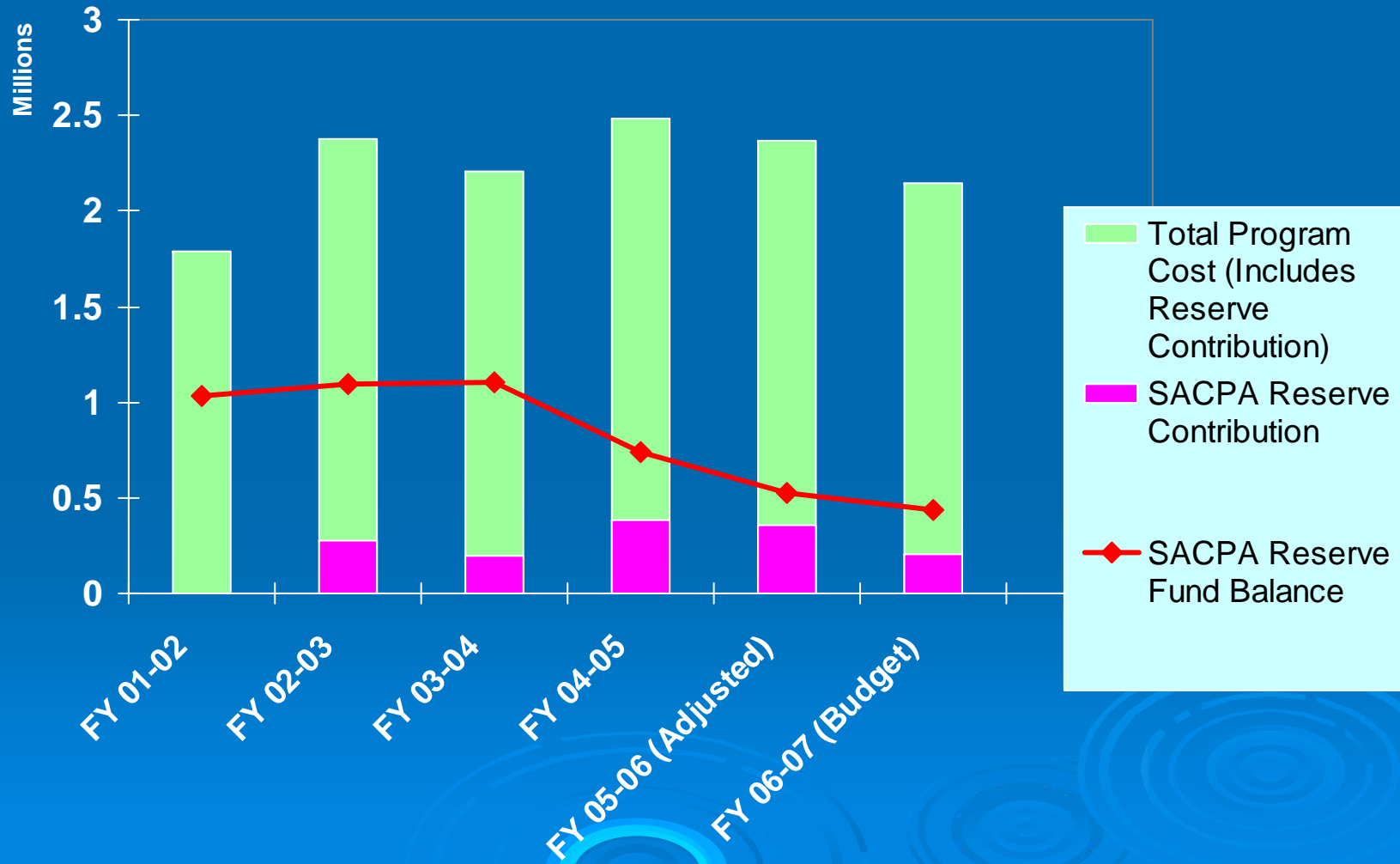

SACPA Outcomes



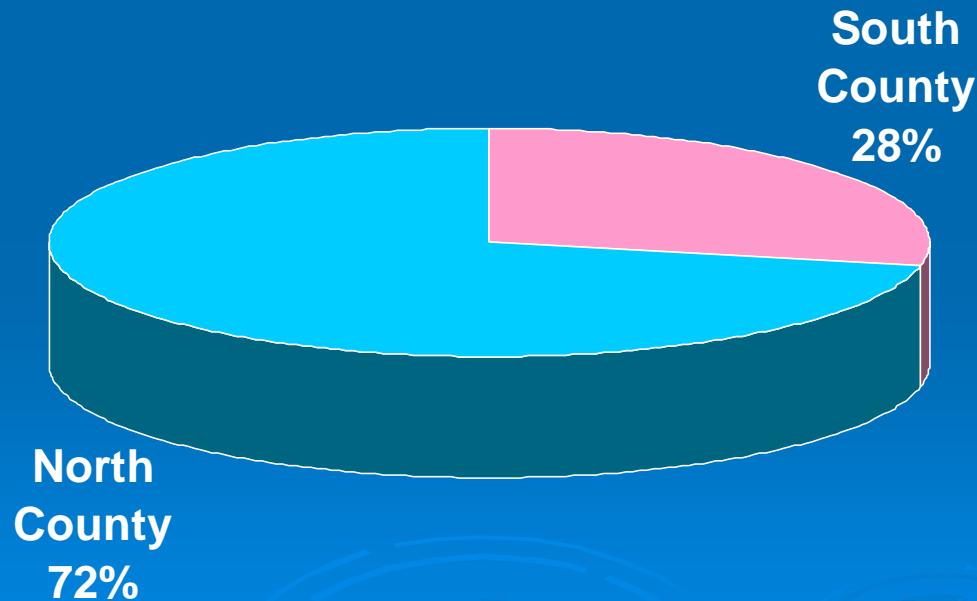
- In the first 6 months of vocational services programs, placed 41% of 64 unemployed SACPA clients in full time work

SACPA Contract Funding By Region Santa Barbara County

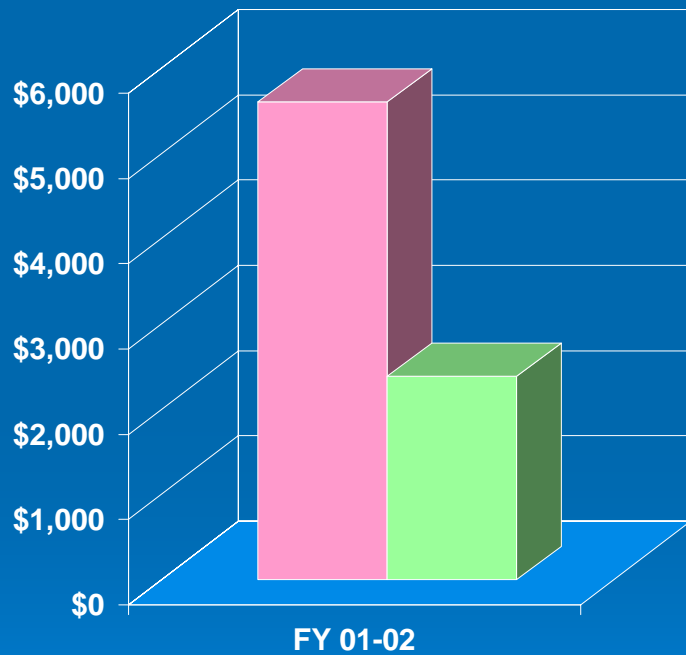
- Treatment contract funding is allocated in proportion to caseload by region



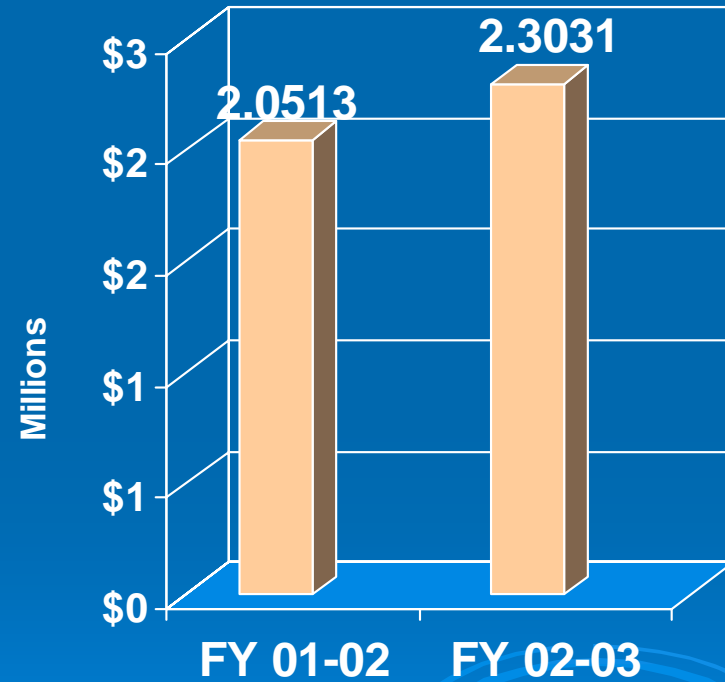

Statewide Savings Per SACPA Participant (UCLA)

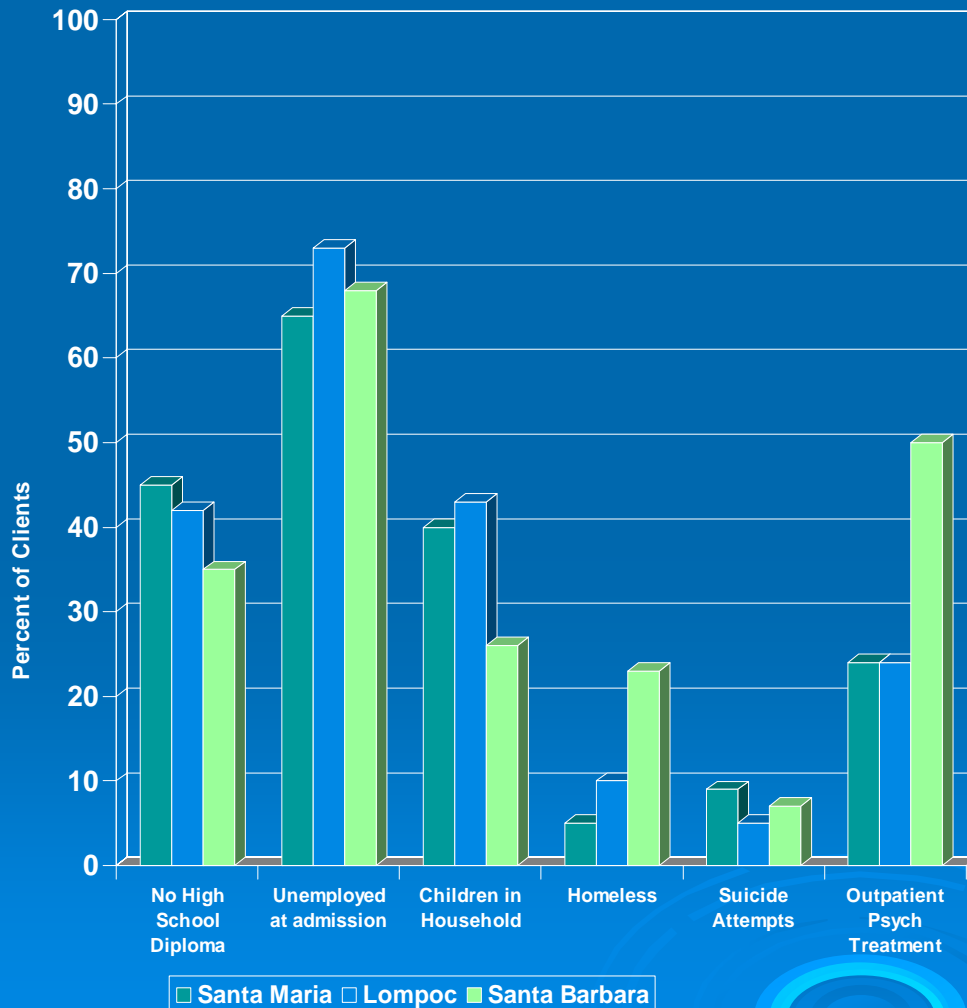


Santa Barbara County Cost Avoidance Estimate

SACPA Client Factors & ADP Service Enhancements



- Added \$123,125 in vocational services
- Increased Perinatal bed capacity by 61%
- Created 3,147 sober living bed days countywide
- Continue enhancement of co-occurring treatment services as response to psychosocial problems

Program Improvements

- Alignment with Drug Court practices
- Explore alternatives to sanctions/ incarceration
- Include drug testing as part of SACPA
- Recommendations:
 - Approve SACPA Annual Services Plan
 - Communicate support of the program to CSAC and legislative representatives
