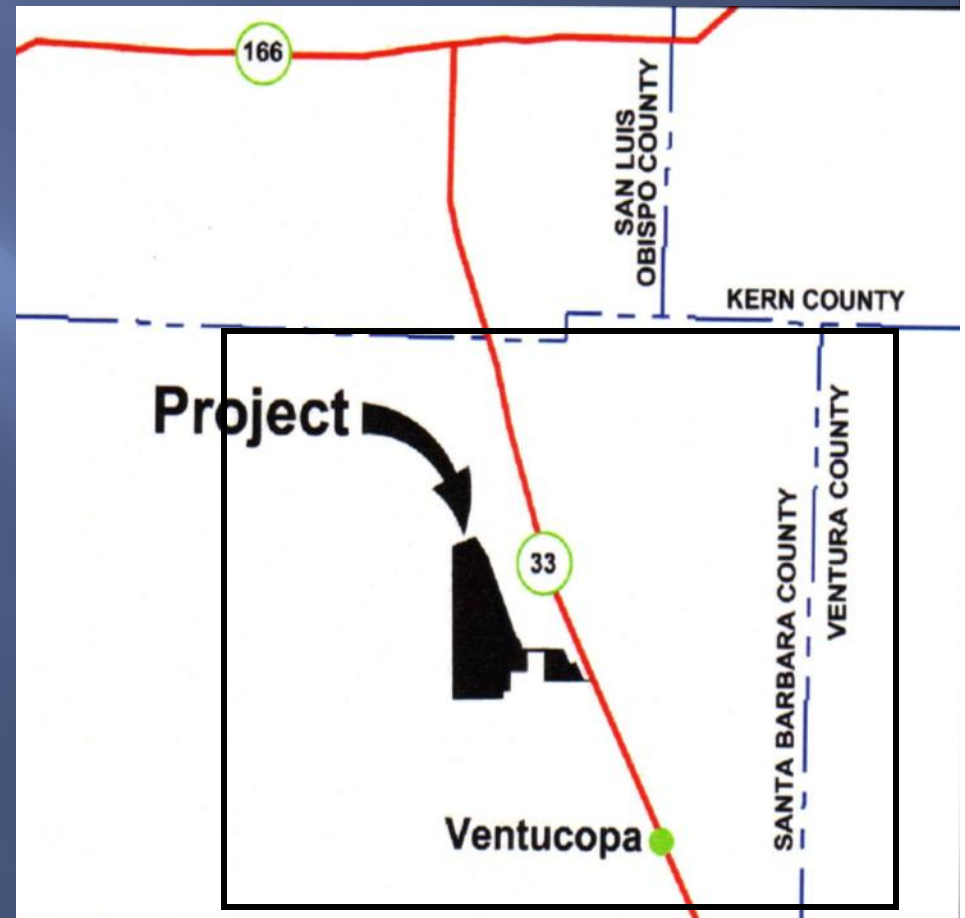
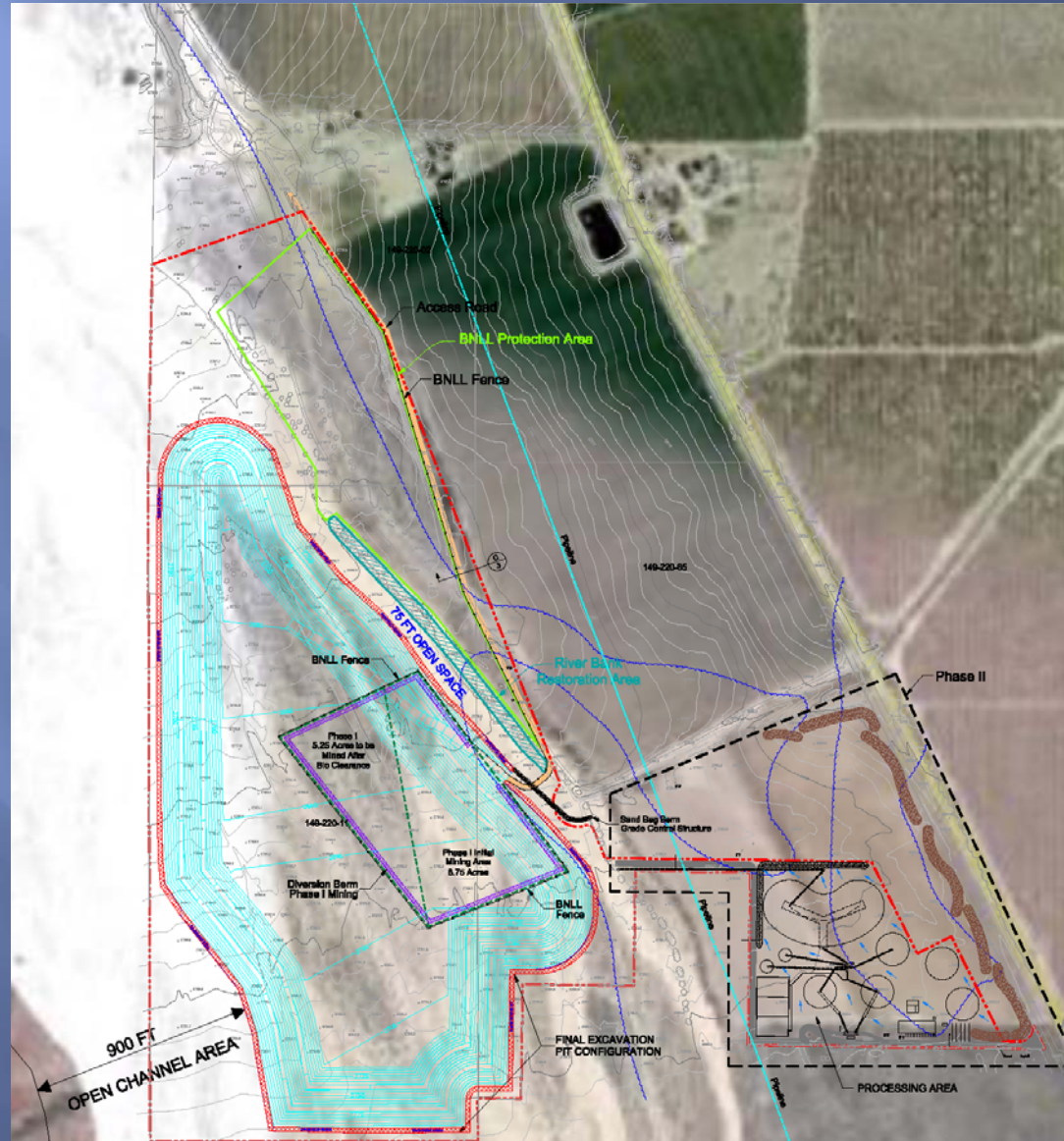

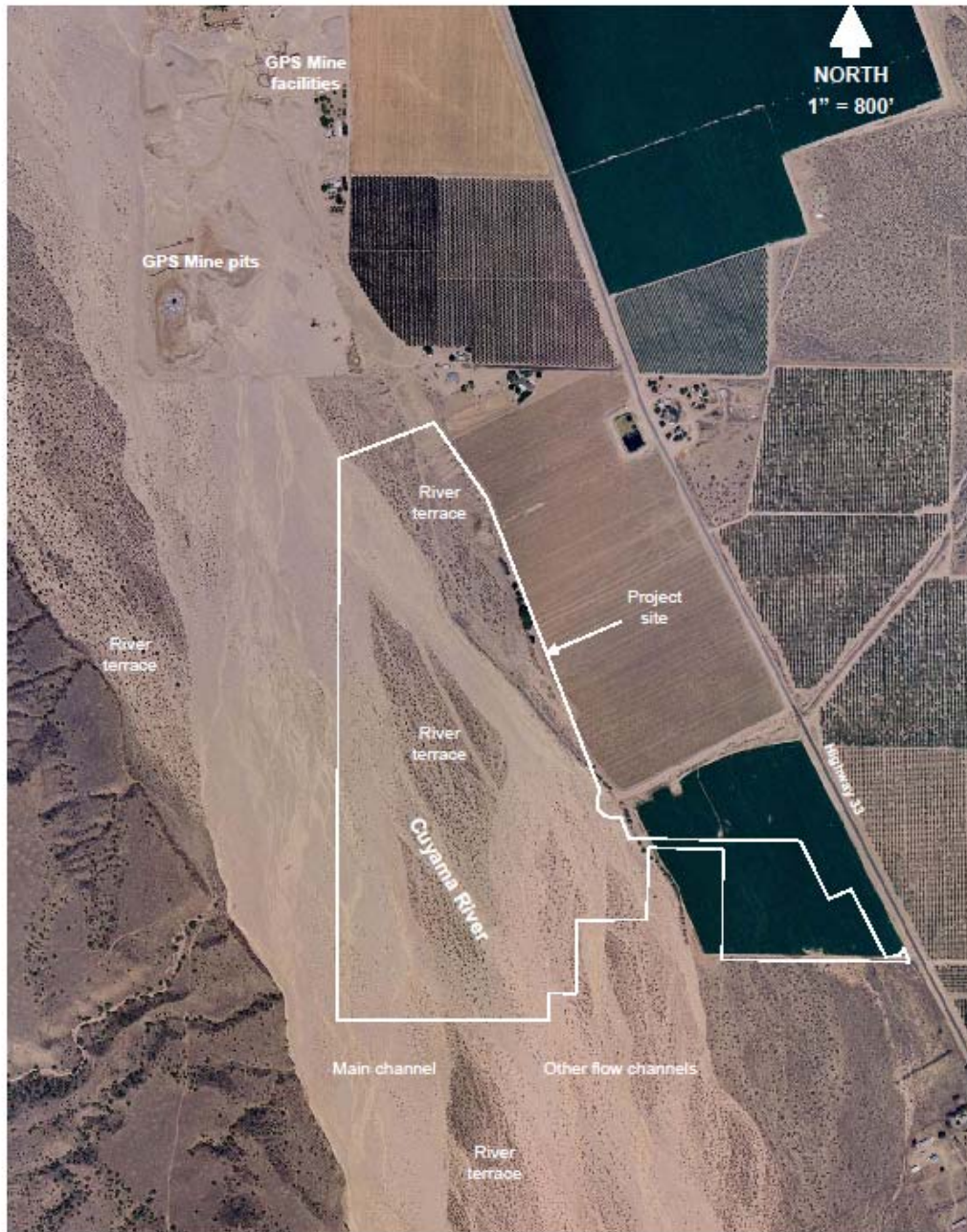


Figure 2-2. Aerial Photograph of the Project Site









Approved Diamond Rock CUP

Proposed CUP Revision

Will produce additional 500,000 tons/yr. (750,000 tons/yr. maximum)

Will defer an increase in allowable production

Will add 100 truck trips/day (50 exit loads), with associated noise and air quality impacts

Will defer the additional truck traffic and associated noise and air quality impacts

Will convert 14.2 acres of agricultural land that is currently in production

Will defer the conversion of agricultural land

Will add new processing facility with associated noise, air quality, water use and visual impacts

Will defer new processing facility and associated noise, air quality, water use and visual impacts

Main Reasons for the Appeal

1. Water supply, water quality and erosion.
2. CEQA – EIR Addendum vs. New EIR
3. Relation to Army Corps. Permit
4. Compliance and Enforcement

STAFF RESPONSE TO APPEAL ISSUES

- 1.No significant impacts on water supply, water quality or erosion.
- 2.Addendum to Final EIR is adequate under CEQA.
- 3.County permit not inconsistent with state and federal permits.
- 4.Permit conditions are enforceable
- 5.Revision would reduce and/or defer impacts of already approved project.

RECOMMENDATION

1. Make the required findings
2. Adopt the Addendum
3. Deny the Appeal
4. Approve CUP Revision
