Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara, State of California, on June 6, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. or shortly thereafter, in the Board of Supervisors Hearing Room, 4th floor of the County Administration Building at 105 East Anapamu Street, Santa Barbara, California, to take public testimony on actions considering adoption of the proposed benefit assessment for sewer service in County Service Area 12 (Mission Canyon Sewer District) as shown in the fixed charge fee report for fiscal year 2017-2018 as well as the proposed California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) exemption per CEQA Guidelines (CCR Section 15273(a)(1)-(4)).
