The recommendation(s) are primarily aligned with Goal No. 1: An Efficient Government Able to Respond Effectively to the Needs of the Community.

#### **Executive Summary and Discussion:**

Santa Barbara County and the Santa Ynez Valley Airport Authority, Inc., have entered into a Lease and Management Agreement for the Santa Ynez Airport. The Second Amendment to this Agreement requires the Authority to prepare an Airport Layout and Land Use Plan with the following components; a narrative report, a combined airport layout drawing and land use drawing, an airport property map, and an element regarding airport noise and traffic patterns. The purpose of this Plan is to identify a vision of the airport and its prospective uses for a period of twenty years. Per the Agreement, the Authority shall modify and updated the Plan every five years.

This Plan has been reviewed and approved by the Federal Aviation Administration, Caltrans Aeronautics Division, Santa Barbara County Association of Governments in its role as the Airport Land Use.
