RESOLUTION HONORING JEFFREY PETERSON UPON ACHIEVING THE RANK OF EAGLE SCOUT

WHEREAS, Jeffrey Peterson graduated from Santa Barbara High School in June 2001 and is now a freshman at UCSB studying computer science; and

WHEREAS, Jeffrey is a member of Boy Scouts of America Troop 126 and is sponsored by The Santa Barbara Ward of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints; and

WHEREAS, Jeffrey's Eagle Service Project was the design and placement of a natural rock bench on the Girard Trail on the mountain above the San Ysidro Ranch; and

WHEREAS, the work on the bench was authorized by the Montecito Trails Foundation and the project's goal was to commemorate the granting of an easement by the Christian Heyer Family to the County; and

WHEREAS, the project was a collective effort of 13 scouts, scoutmasters, and scout parents who worked a total of 160 man-hours on this bench carrying in 2000 lbs. of cement in backpacks plus approximately 100 gallons of water and moving thousands of pounds of rock.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors honors and commends Jeffrey Peterson for achieving the rank of Eagle Scout, and thanks him for his contributions to this community, and wishes him great success in the future.
