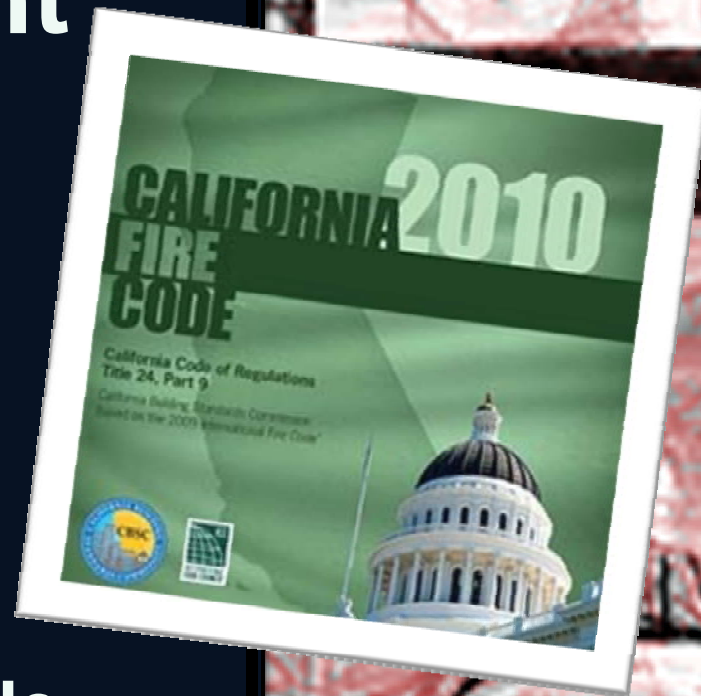

## Fire Code Adoption

### Specific 2010 Fire Code Amendments





**This proposal will adopt the 2010 California Fire Code with Amendments under Chapter 15 of the County Code. (We are currently using the 2007 version adopted in January 2009.)**

**The 2010 California Fire Code as adopted by the State will become State Law effective January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011.**

# 2010 FIRE CODE AMENDMENTS

## CHAPTER 6: Building Services and Systems is amended as follows:

Language has been added to address the installation of photovoltaic systems on buildings and structures.

The language does not apply to installations on one and two family dwellings.



# 2010 FIRE CODE AMENDMENTS

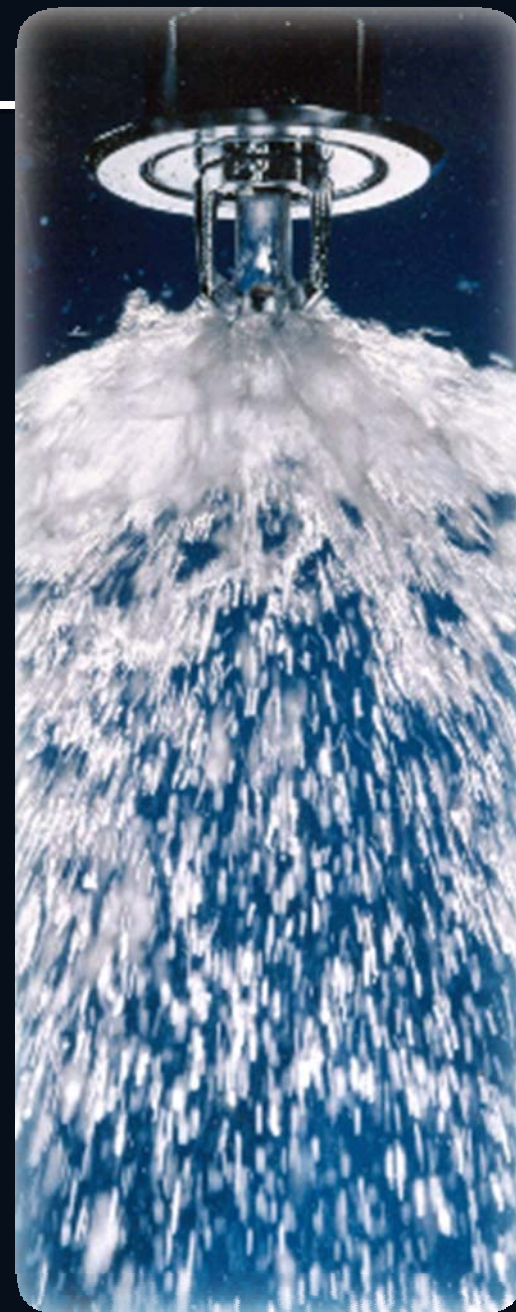
## Chapter 9: Fire Protection Systems

**903.7.1 Locations Required** is amended as follows:

Chapter 9 incorporates several changes for automatic fire protection systems.

As of January 1, 2011, all new one and two family dwellings and town homes are required to have automatic fire protection systems (sprinklers). This is required by the adoption of the 2010 California Residential Code, Chapter 3, Section R-313, Automatic Fire Sprinkler Systems.

Also in Chapter 9 is added the following requirement: Any additional square footage added after January 1, 2011 shall be accumulative towards future sprinkler requirements.



# 2010 FIRE CODE AMENDMENTS

## CHAPTER 49: Requirements for Wildland-Urban Interface Fire Areas

Chapter 47 has now been moved to Chapter 49 of the 2010 California Fire Code.



# 2010 FIRE CODE AMENDMENTS

## APPENDIX D

**Fire Apparatus Access Roads—Language was added to address aerial fire apparatus access roads and overhead obstructions.**
