That the Board of Supervisors accept and file the Certification of Results for the Los Olivos Community Services District Formation Mail Ballot Election held on January 30, 2018, as required by law.

**Summary Text:**

The results of the January 30, 2018 Los Olivos Community Services District Formation Mail Ballot Election was certified on February 8, 2018. In accordance with Government Code Section 57149, the elections official immediately reported the results of the election to the executive officer of the local agency formation commission. Elections Code § 15372 requires the Registrar of Voters to prepare a certified statement of the results of the election and submit it to the governing body within 30 days of the election. An official Certificate of Results of Canvass and Statement of Votes Cast (Attachment A) is attached. The official results are also available on the Clerk, Recorder and Assessor & Registrar of Voters website at [www.sbcvote.com](http://www.sbcvote.com).

Election Code § 15400 requires that the governing body shall declare the results of the election for each measure under its jurisdiction.

Elections Code § 15620 allows any voter, within five days following the completion of the canvass, to file a request for recount with the county elections official of the votes cast for candidates for any office, or any measure provided that the office or measure is not voted on statewide. The "completion of the

canvass” shall be presumed to be that time when the elections official signs the certified statement of the results of the election. As the signing of the certified statement occurred on February 8, 2018, the written request for a recount needed to be filed with the elections office no later than 5:00 pm on Tuesday, February 13, 2018. No written request for a recount was filed.
