**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

WITH REFERENCE TO THE FOLLOWING:

- A. Whereas on January 7, 1980, by Resolution No. 80-12, the County of Santa Barbara (County) Board of Supervisors (Board) adopted the Santa Barbara County Coastal Land Use Plan.
- B. Whereas on July 19, 1982, by Ordinance No. 3312, the Board adopted Article II, the Coastal Zoning Ordinance (CZO), of Chapter 35 of the Santa Barbara County Code.
- C. Whereas the Board, having found it to be in the interest of the general community welfare, consistent with the County’s Comprehensive Plan, Coastal Land Use Plan, the requirements of State planning and zoning law, and good planning and zoning practices, adopted the following amendment to the Santa Barbara County Local Coastal Program (LCP):

On May 18, 2021, the Board adopted Ordinance No. 5134 (20ORD-00000-00001) amending the CZO of Chapter 35, Zoning, of the Santa Barbara County Code to implement new State regulations and development standards regarding accessory dwelling units (ADUs) and junior accessory dwelling units (JADUs)
- D. Whereas the Board held duly noticed public hearings on the CZO amendment referenced above, at which time the amendment was explained and comments were invited from persons in attendance.
- E. Whereas the Board now wishes to submit this amendment to the California Coastal Commission (CCC) for review and certification.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED as follows:

- 1. The above recitations are true and correct.
- 2. Pursuant to the provisions of Government Code Section 65857 and Public Resources Code Section 30514, the Board adopted the above described changes as amendments to the Santa Barbara County Local Coastal Program.
- 3. The Board certifies that these amendments are intended to be carried out in a matter fully in conformity with the Coastal Act of 1976.
- 4. The Board directs the Planning and Development Department to submit this Resolution to the Executive Director of the CCC for review and certification.

5. The Chair of the Board and Clerk of the Board are hereby authorized and directed to sign and certify all documents and other materials in accordance with this Resolution to reflect the Board’s action described above.
