Many of the buildings have high ceiling vaulted entryways. This lift is able to be brought into buildings and used on any level grounds inside or outside, and is easily portable to other locations. It is used to assist staff in changing light bulbs, cleaning vaulted areas, repairing ceiling tiles, painting, cleaning roof gutters, changing parking lot lights, working on HVAC systems, changing motors on exhaust fans, and allows staff a safe alternative to ladders.

Justification:	The Fire Department is requesting a transfer of appropriations in the amount of \$864,000 to properly classify hardware and software development associated with the implementation of the Regional Fire Communications Center. These appropriations were originally established in the IT Software Maintenance account under Services & Supplies but should be recorded under Capital Assets. In addition, the installation of an emergency generator at Station 24 in Los Alamos was appropriated under the structure maintenance/improvement line item under Services & Supplies but must be capitalized along with the purchase of the generator per Auditor-Controller guidelines. Likewise, appropriations for a heating and air conditioning system at Station 21 in Orcutt are also being moved from structure maintenance/improvements under Services and Supplies to Capital Assets.

- Title: Committed Fund Balance Draw for BOS 3rd District Discretionary Funding
- Budget Action: Increase appropriations of \$25,000 in General County Programs General Fund for Services and Supplies funded by a release of Committed Emerging Issues fund balance.
- Justification: The General County Program's FY 22-23 adopted budget included a \$73,000 allocation to the Board of Supervisor's Third District for discretionary spending. At the May 9th, 2023 Board hearing, the Board approved a \$25,000 contribution from the Third District's discretionary spending allocation to the SB ACT organization for coordination and collaboration of a Lompoc Homelessness Service Plan. This contribution to SB ACT was not actualized in FY 22-23 and was therefore preserved in the General County Program's Emerging Issues Committed Fund Balance. The contribution was instead actualized in FY 23-24, requiring a draw from fund balance of the unspent funds from FY 22-23. This budget revision increases services and supplies appropriations in the General County Programs General Fund in the amount of \$25,000 and is funded by a draw from General County Programs General Fund Emerging Issues Committed Fund Balance.
