SUBJECT: Coastal Resource Enhancement Fund (CREF) – Grant Contract

Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors execute the attached CREF contract (BC03-159) with the City of Carpinteria to design, fabricate and install ten signs at the Carpinteria Salt Marsh Nature Park, in the amount of \$38,500 for the period of February 18, 2003 to November 15, 2003.

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendation aligns with Goal No. 5. A High Quality of Life for All Residents.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

In March of 2002, the Board of Supervisors awarded the City of Carpinteria a \$38,500 CREF grant to design, fabricate, and install ten signs at the Carpinteria Salt Marsh Nature Park. These signs, along with nine existing signs, will make up the Nature Park's interpretative series.

Mandates and Service Levels:

Mitigation of impacts to coastal resources from offshore oil and gas development is required as a condition of permits on five projects. Mitigation is provided through the Coastal Resource Enhancement Fund. There are no changes in service level as a result of this agreement.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

Subject: CREF Agreement Agenda Date: February 18, 2003

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No fiscal and facilities impacts. The Coastal Resource Enhancement Fund is funded by mitigation fees paid by developers of offshore oil and gas reserves. Staff costs to prepare this agreement have been offset by interest accrued to the Coastal Resource Enhancement Fund. The \$38,500 for the ten interpretative signs is expended from Fund #0063, Department #053, Program #5090, Account #7863, Project #0203. The CREF program is part of the mitigation program within the Energy Division Cost Center on page D-276 in the Planning & Development Department's section of the County's Budget F02/03.
