

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO
AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES OF INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR
BY AND BETWEEN
COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA
AND
FEDERAL ENGINEERING, INC.**

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT (“First Amendment”) to Agreement for Services of Independent Contractor is made by and between the County of Santa Barbara, a political subdivision of the State of California (“County”), and Federal Engineering, Inc., a Maryland corporation (“Contractor”) registered to do business in California, whose principal place of business is located at 10560 Arrowhead Drive, Suite 100, Fairfax, VA 22030.

WHEREAS, the County and Contractor are parties to that certain **Agreement for Services of Independent Contractor BC21095** dated July 13, 2021 (“Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, the County and Contractor desire to amend the term of the Agreement to extend the term until June 30, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants set forth herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, County and Contractor agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. Section 4 of the Agreement to read in its entirety as follows:

“The term of this Agreement shall commence on July 13, 2021, and shall terminate on June 30, 2026, unless earlier terminated in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement (“Term”). Contractor shall complete performance of all of the services set forth in the Statement of Work attached hereto as EXHIBIT A during the Term.”

2. Effectiveness of Agreement. Except as expressly modified by Section 1 above, all of the provisions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.
3. Authority. Each of the parties hereto represents and warrants that such party’s respective signatories to this First Amendment have the power and authority to enter into this First Amendment in the capacities set forth in such party’s signature block(s), below, and such party has fully complied with all formal requirements necessary for such party to enter into this First Amendment, and for this First Amendment to be legally binding on such party. Contractor hereby certifies and warrants that entering into this First Amendment shall not cause Contractor to breach the terms or conditions of any other contract or agreement to which Contractor is a party or which is otherwise binding on Contractor.
4. Counterparts. This First Amendment may be executed in several counterparts, all of which taken together shall be deemed to be originals and shall constitute a single agreement between the parties hereto.
