Hi, we were unable to attend the April 4th meeting, and these are the key points we are in favor of:

- Remove agricultural land rezoning from the county housing element
- Ensure all housing projects are subject to CEQA, California Environmental Quality Act to adequately plan for the environmental and infrastructure impacts on the totality of the units proposed in the SB County Housing element.
- Spread high-density, low-income housing across the county with more balanced distribution to north county and to areas with limited units added (Carpinteria and Montecito, for example).
- Remove the number of surplus units proposed to meet the RHNA requirement. (The state RHNA requirement for unincorporated SB County is to add 5664 units. The SB County Housing Element has proposed a total of 15,898 additional units, representing over 10,000 additional unnecessary homes and population explosion.)

PLEASE, do not add so much high density to our community, in such a rush. This is a short sighted approach. Your proposals will add so much traffic, increase water usage and negatively impact our community. Goleta has already overbuilt, and the congestion is terrible. What you are proposing will cause so much gridlock-

Hi BOS friends,

Some CBC/Sweeps tenants are now asking what happens to their leases if they expire soon (say, in 1-2 months). This depends on a few things but there is some precarity here. Something else very reasonable you could do, in also copying SB City, is the mandatory 1 year lease offer. See here:

This would be really helpful for when tenants reach end of the lease term, and the landlord then has to OFFER the option of a 1 year lease. The tenant can take it or leave it. If the tenant rejects the offer they're defaulted onto a month to month lease, or they can agree to leave.

This protection has been very helpful for tenants in the City of SB and would be immensely helpful for tenants in IV and throughout unincorporated county as well.
