That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve and authorize the contribution of \$5,000 to United Way of Northern Santa Barbara County, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, (EIN #95-6006513), to support their Literacy 2.0 Program from the Fifth District General County Programs Department 990 discretionary fund;
- b) Find that the project provides a community benefit that meets the social needs of the County; and
- c) Determine that the above actions are organizational or administrative activities of the government that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment and are not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to section 15378(b)(5) of the CEQA Guidelines.

Summary Text:

Upon adoption of the County's FY 2023-24 Budget, each supervisorial office was allocated \$100,000 of discretionary funding to direct toward projects and/or programs in the County in need of funding. These funding requests must be approved by the full Board of Supervisors.
