**SUBJECT:** Contract renewal for the Carpinteria City Police Services Contract

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**Recommendation(s):**

That the Board of Supervisors:

Execute the attached contract to provide general Law Enforcement services to the City of Carpinteria by the Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Department through the conclusion of Fiscal Year 2006-2007.

**Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:**

The recommendation is primarily aligned with Goal No. 2: A Safe and Health Community in Which to Live, Work and Visit, plus actions required by laws or routine business necessity.

**Executive Summary and Discussion:**

On July 1, 1992, the City of Carpinteria entered into a contract with the County of Santa Barbara for the Sheriff to provide Police Services within the incorporated area of Carpinteria City.

The original contract was for a five year period, July 1, 1992 through June 30, 1997. The original contract was renewed for an additional five year period ending on June 30, 2002. Upon the conclusion of the second contract for Police Services, both parties agreed to a contract extension to allow for negotiations of a new contract. A new contract for Police Services was negotiated ending June 30, 2007.

It is important to note that the contracts have included an automatic renewal for an additional five years.

**Mandates and Service Levels:**

This is not a mandated service; however, in order to provide this requested assistance to the City of Carpinteria, this contractual agreement is necessary. This action creates no change in programs or service level.

**Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:**

In keeping with current law, County Policy, and practice, this contract provides for “Full Cost Recovery” for services rendered, and realizes no increase in net county costs. With approval of this contract, appropriate entries reflecting the inclusion of this contract will continue to be included within the Sheriff’s submitted proposed budgets during the duration of the contract.

There are no anticipated facility impacts in continuing this contract service.
